AS "NOT MENT. 2000RS, WITH STRAIGHT, NOT SLOPED, REAR WINDOW, THEN TRUNK EX-TENDING BACK FROM WINDOW, BUT NOT LONG. ADVISED IT HAD SMOOTH SIDES, POSSIBLY 2 RECTANGLE WITH 1 CIRCLE IN BETWEEN TAILLIGHTS NO MOLDING. ALSO NOTICED NO LICENSE PLATE LIGHT AND WHEN HE-BOTH LEFT AND RIGHT. NO DISTINGUISHING MARKS ON HIS AND BLACK FOOTWEAR, FACE, JUST DESCRIBED AS ROUND AND LARGE. DID NOT APPEAR TO BE CARRYING ANYTHING .-- DROVE AWAY IN A HURRY. AND "GUNNED THE MOTOR, BUT THE CAR WAS REASONABLY QUIET WITH GOOD EXHAUST." ADVISED WHEN HE GOT HIS VEH.
