INTO THE SNOW BANK, THE FRONT END ALSO  
SION OF THE LICENSE PLATE, WHICH APPEARS

UPON COLLECTING EVIDENCE VISIBLE ON AND AROUND THE

THE CARPET WAS THEN PULLED UP AND WE RECOVERED BULLET FRAGMENTS  
FROM UNDER THE CARPET NOT SEEN FROM ON TOP OF THE CARPET. WE ALSO UL-  
TIMATELY HAD TO CUT OPEN THE LARGE LIVINGROOM COUCH AND RECOVER BULLET  
FRAGMENTS FROM INSIDE AFTER FINDING ENTRANCE HOLES. PHOTOS OF THE  
EVIDENCE WERE OBTAINED AS EACH WAS FOUND.

LT. DAYNE AND HICKMAN RETURNED TO THE SCENE. THEY ADVISED THEY HAD  
WENT TO THE HOSPITAL AND SPOKE TO RUDEL, WHO WAS STILL THERE, BUT  
READY TO LEAVE AND GO INTO HIDING. RUDEL TOLD THEM THAT RODNEY MELTON  
HAD COME TO THE HOSPITAL AND TOLD RUDEL IN FRONT OF OTHER FAMILY MEMBERS  
\* THAT THIS HAPPENED BECAUSE RUDEL MARRIED ON THE PEOPLE IN CRESTLINE \*

THE OFFICERS ADVISED THE CASE INVOLVING ~~ROBERT WOODS JR~~ GENE KEITH  
SR. GENE KEITH SR. DEMITRIUS REEVES, ~~AT PRICE~~ THEY  
ADVISED THAT GENE KEITH SR. HAD TOLD SOMEONE THAT THEY WERE "GOING TO  
WHACK FAMILIES" IN RETRIBUTION FOR THEIR ARRESTS.

DAYNE AND HICKMAN WERE ASKED TO CONTINUE TO GATHER INFORMATION  
WITH THEIR CONTACTS AND TO DO A REPORT OF ALL THE INFORMATION THEY  
RECEIVED, THEY ADVISED THEY WOULD.

THE MANAGER HAD BEEN CONTACTED AND CAME TO THE APARTMENT AND  
CHANGED THE LOCKS ON THE DOOR SO NO OTHER KEYS WOULD BE ABLE TO BE  
USED, HE THEN GAVE ME THE KEY TO THE APARTMENT.

FINISHED PROCESSING THEN SCENE, LEFT AND SECURED THE DOOR AT  
0527HRS.

AT 0625HRS. I WENT TO BUCYRUS COMMUNITY HOSPITAL E.R. AND SPOKE TO  
NURSE V. TEYNOR, RN. AND VIEWED THE FACE SHEETS FOR THE FOUR VICTIMS  
TRANSPORTED THERE. THEY WERE AS FOLLOWS:

#1 MARCHAE D. CHATMAN, DOB:06/10/89, AGE 4. SHE DIED OF HER WOUNDS IN  
THE E.R. AT 10:32PM. NOTES SHOWED TWO GUNSHOT ENTRANCE WOUNDS TO THE  
BACK AND TWO EXIT WOUNDS TO THE FRONT.

#2 QUANITA M. REEVES, DOB:11/27/86, AGE 7. SHE WAS TRANSPORTED BY  
HELICOPTER TO CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL IN COLUMBUS, OHIO. NOTES INDICATED AN  
ENTRANCE WOUND TO THE LEFT BUTTOCK AND ARM, AND EXIT WOUNDS TO BELLY  
GROIN AREAS (2).

ITON M. REEVES, DOB:06/17/89, AGE 4. HE WAS TRANSPORTED BY  
HELICOPTER TO CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL IN COLUMBUS, OHIO. NOTES INDICATED  
ENTRANCE WOUND TO RT. FLANK, AND ENTRANCE WOUND TO RT. BUTTOCK, EXIT  
WOUND TO LEFT UPPER ABDOMEN.

WARD A. WARREN, DOB:07/03/70, AGE 23. HE WAS TRANSPORTED BY  
HELICOPTER TO GRANT HOSPITAL IN COLUMBUS, OHIO. NOTES INDICATED  
ENTRANCE WOUND TO LEFT CHEEK W/ EXIT TO RT. CHIN, ENTRANCE WOUND IN  
LEFT CHEEK W/EXIT TO RT. SHOULDER, ENTRANCE AND EXIT WOUNDS TO LOWER  
GROIN, AND ENTRANCE TO LEFT BUTTOCK W/EXIT TO LEFT GROIN.
