To Our Daycare Friends

Daycare Rules and Information:

 All dogs must attend at least 2 Days a week, Monday through Friday. Our friends are welcome to come more than two of the days but have to come at least two to be in the program.

 We charge a \$30.00 start up fee. This is because we take the time to SLOWLY acclimate your pet in with our other daycare friends.

 We charge a minimum of 2 days even if you do not attend. This is to make sure that all of our daycare friends are continuously acclimated. This charge will be dropped if previously approved. For example: Going on Vacation, Sickness or injury. If not pre approved this charge will apply.

 If your pet is absent for 2 weeks with out letting us know we are going to assume that you are no longer in need of daycare. At that point you can call us and if we still have that spot open you can rejoin the daycare program. this means there will be a \$30.00 start up fee again. If no spots are open we can put you on the waiting list for daycare.

 If your dog shows aggression towards his/her fellow daycare friends or the staff we reserve the right to dismiss him/her from the daycare program. we DO NOT tolerate any aggression in the program. We want our furry friends to have a safe and fun environment to be in.

 In the summer time we do have a kiddy pool out for our friends to play in on nice days. There is that possibility that your pet may go home a little wet or damp. We will not separate any dogs due to the pool. Too many of our daycare friends love the water.

 All dogs must be spayed or Neutered at 6 months of age unless advised by your vet to wait until 8 months to a year, if advised at that time by vet a note must be provided by said vet to excuse from the 6 month rule.

 All shots and fecal testing needs to be up to date and maintained to be in daycare.

 Daycare hours are: Monday - Friday; 6 to 10 am for drop off an 3 to 6 pm for pick up. There will be a \$10.00 charge for every fifteen minutes late. Please be courteous to our hours.

 We would like to add that these are animals with a mind of there own in group play. There is never a 100% guarantee that there will be no Fights, Injuries or Illness. We do work are hardest to make sure that nothing does happen but when you have a group playing together there is always that possibility. If a dog does show signs of aggression we do not let them play in the group anymore. If your pet is the one that caused injuries to another furry friend, you will be responsible for veterinary costs.
