Post-Fire Threat: Illegal Occupation

After the Eaton Fire, thousands of vacant properties are left unprotected.

These survivors now face:

Illegal occupants moving onto their lots

Long, costly court evictions

Delayed rebuilding and healing

Legal Shield: Letter of Agency

The LA County Sheriff's Department encourages homeowners to file a Letter of Agency under Penal Code 602, empowering law enforcement to:

- 1 - Immediately remove trespassers
- 2 - Prevent further illegal occupation
- 3 - Protect properties during rebuild

 Perimeter fencing + "No Trespassing" signage required

The How

 What's Needed for Each Property

 Volunteer Time

- ~1 hour per home
- 3–5 person team
- 5–7 homes per workday

Materials List

- 300 ft. construction fencing
- 5' wood stakes (every 6–8 ft)
- Zip ties, staple guns
- “No Trespassing” signs
- Optional: 6' steel T-posts (for hard soil)

Tools

- 4 lb. sledgehammer or mallet
- Picket pounder
- Safety gloves

Estimated Cost per Home: \$250

- Fencing (300 ft) \$120
- Stakes \$60
- Zip ties / staples \$20
- Signage (6–8 signs) \$30
- Total \$250
