### Legal Shield: Letter of Agency

The LA County Sheriff's Department encourages homeowners to file a Letter of Agency under Penal Code 602, empowering law enforcement to:

- 1 Immediately remove trespassers
- 2 Prevent further illegal occupation
- 3 Protect properties during rebuild
- Perimeter fencing + "No Trespassing" signage required 📍 Submit at: 780 E. Altadena Drive, Altadena CA

#### We Need Partners to Scale This Response

#### The How

- What's Needed for Each Property
- Volunteer Time
  - ~1 hour per home
  - 3-5 person team
  - 5–7 homes per workday



- 300 ft. construction fencing
- 5' wood stakes (every 6–8 ft)
- Zip ties, staple guns
- "No Trespassing" signs
- Optional: 6' steel T-posts (for hard soil)

#### **X** Tools

- 4 lb. sledgehammer or mallet
- Picket pounder
- Safety gloves

#### **Estimated Cost per Home: \$250**

- Fencing (300 ft) \$120
- Stakes \$60
- Zip ties / staples \$20
- Signage (6–8 signs) \$30
- Total \$250
