

# Adaptable Shawlette

Colors of Crooked Tree Yarn Thick and Thin Cotton (sample is 495 yards) -1 cupcake or Colors of Crooked Tree Dk Weight Wool (132 yards) - 2 skeins for a larger shawlette.

Dense and smaller shawlette: 10mm needle

Larger looser shawlette: 15mm needle

Cast on 11 stitches loosely.

Knit 5 rows in garter stitch.

1. Row (RS): K2, yo, K3, yo, pm, K1 (This is the center stitch), yo, K3, yo, K2.

2. Row (WS): Knit all stitches.

3. Row (RS): K2, yo, knit to marker, yo, move marker, K1, yo, knit two stitches before end, yo, K2.

4. Row (WS): Knit all stitches.

Repeat rows 3 and 4 until you have almost knitted all your yarn, but keep enough yarn for binding off loosely. If you like you can add tassels (make them ahead of time). You can soak and block the shawlette for a neat look.

Note: Place a marker before the center stitch so you won't forget it.
