LAKE EFFECT SCAP

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MEASUREMENTS

57 in long by 6.5 in wide

MATERIALS

2 skeins of Crooked Tree Yarn (50% Wensleydale X, 50% English Leicester), one each of color A & B, plus 2oz of A for fringe (optional).

NEEDLES

1 pair size US7 (4.5mm) needles

GAUGE (in pattern)

12 rows and 12 stitches for 2x2 inch square.

KNIT YOUR SCARF...

Using size 7 needles and color B, cast on 39 stitches.

Knit 3 rows

Row 1 Using color A k to end.

Row 2 Using color A, p1, (p2tog) twice, *p2, yo, (p1, yo, p1) into next st, yo, p2, p2tog, p3tog, p2tog; rep from * once more, p2, yo, (p1, yo, p1) into next st, yo, p2, (p2tog) twice, p1.

Row 3 Using A, k to end, working into back of yos in previous row.

Row 4 Using A, as row 2.

Row 5 Using B, k to end, working into back of yos in previous row.

Rows 6, 7 and 8, Using B knit to end.

These 8 rows will form the wave pattern of your scarf. Repeat pattern until your scarf measures 53in (you should have 42 rows in color B).

Using B bind off loosely

Edging (make 2)

Using color A cast on 20 sts

Row 1 (WS) Bind off 16 st, k to end.

Row 2 (RS) k4, cast on 10 st, bind off 10 st, knit to.

Row 3 k4, cast on 8 st, bind off 8 sts, k to end.

Row 4 k4, cast on 12 sts, bind off 12 sts, k to end

Row 6 k4, cast on 6 sts, bind off 6 sts, k to end.

Row 8 k4, cast on 8 sts, bind off 8 sts, k to end.

Row 10 k4, cast on 14 sts, bind off 14 sts, k to end.

Repeat rows 2-10, 4 times.

Last row k4, cast on 16 sts, bind off remaining 20 sts.

Finish your scarf

Sew fringe strips to scarf ends.

Sew in yarn ends and block and your scarf.
