# Love and a Road Runner: How One Man Finally Landed His Dream Car



When I was 15 years old, I watched the indie crime movie Love and a .45 with my dad. A blue 1972 Plymouth Road Runner is featured prominently in the flick, and I told my dad, "That's the car I want!" Two weeks later, I found a 1973 Road Runner with a 318 V-8 and a 727 automatic in the classifieds section of the newspaper. It wasn't quite the body style I wanted, but I ended up buying the Plymouth, and it served me well through high school and up to present day. It also opened the door to a great community of people, many of whom I met as they were driving by the house and decided to stop to chat about my car.



A couple of decades later, a friend of mine mentioned he knew someone who was thinking about letting go of his 71 Plymouth which is the same body style as the '72 in *Love and a .45*. It took me a year to persuade the owner to sell his Plymouth to me. When the car was finally in my possession, it was a restoration in progress. The previous owner completed many of the hard parts, like the fresh Hemi Orange paint job and a rebuild of the 440 cubic inch V8 engine and A833 four-speed manual transmission. I took care of finishing touches like the carburetor, exhaust, fuel system, shifter linkage, and seatbelts.
