



Virtual Town Hall scheduled for Commonwealth Attorney debate

On Aug. 31, 2020 at 7p.m., Virginians for Judicial Reform will host a Virtual Town Hall for the candidates running for Sussex County Commonwealth's Attorney in the Nov. 3, 2020 special election.

Candidates Lindsay R. Hartz and Vincent L. Robertson will be joining moderator Lisa Spees, Director of Virginians for Judicial Reform, for the live ZOOM event which Spees described as a form of candidates' debate.

"This event is being offered as an opportunity for Sussex County Citizens to hear the vision of each candidate directly from the candidates," Spees related. "This is our first Virtual Town Hall, as, with Covid-19, in-person events are tricky. So, we decided to see if the candidates would be interested in doing a town hall with us, and they both were."

"This is a way to let people get answers directly from the candidates," she continued. "Voters need to understand each candidate's background, what they have done professionally, and anything else that they want to know in order to make an informed decision."
