HILLCREST SUPPLEMENTAL LANDSCAPING RECOMMENDATIONS

Flowering Shrubs & Accent Plants

These plants provide structure, color, and seasonal interest while being drought-tolerant.

Tecoma 'Ball of Fire' (Orange Bells)

✓ Size: 4-6 ft tall, 4-6 ft wide

✓ Foliage: Deep green, glossy, semi-evergreen

✓ Flowers: Bright orange-red, trumpet-shaped clusters in warm seasons

√ Water Needs: Low to moderate

✓ Best Use: Privacy screen, color accent, hummingbird attractor

Tecoma 'Bells of Fire'

✓ Size: 4-5 ft tall, 3-4 ft wide

✓ Foliage: Lush green, slightly smaller leaves than 'Ball of Fire'

✓ Flowers: Reddish-orange, continuous blooms in warm months

√ Water Needs: Low to moderate

✓ Best Use: Foundation plant, courtyard accent, pollinator-friendly

Texas Sage (Leucophyllum frutescens)

✓ Size: 4-6 ft tall, 4-6 ft wide

✓ Foliage: Silvery-green, velvety texture✓ Flowers: Purple, blooming after rain

√ Water Needs: Very low

✓ Best Use: Modern hedge, drought-tolerant privacy screen







Butterfly Bush (Buddleia species)

✓ Size: 5-8 ft tall, 4-6 ft wide

✓ Foliage: Soft green, semi-deciduous

✓ Flowers: Purple, pink, or white, fragrant, attracts butterflies

√ Water Needs: Low

✓ Best Use: Pollinator-friendly, colorful backdrop

Woolly Butterfly Bush (Buddleia marrubiifolia)

✓ Size: 3-5 ft tall, 3-5 ft wide

✓ Foliage: Silvery-gray, fine-textured

✓ Flowers: Small orange globes in spring-summer

√ Water Needs: Very low

✓ Best Use: Accent shrub, wildlife-friendly xeriscape

Chuparosa (Justicia californica)

✓ Size: 3-5 ft tall, 4-6 ft wide

✓ **Foliage:** Sparse, green-gray stems

✓ Flowers: Red, tubular, peak bloom in fall-spring

√ Water Needs: Very low

✓ Best Use: Naturalistic desert gardens, hummingbird attractor

Red Mexican Bird of Paradise (Caesalpinia pulcherrima)

✓ Size: 6-8 ft tall, 4-6 ft wide

✓ Foliage: Feathery, bright green, semi-deciduous

✓ Flowers: Fiery red-orange with long stamens, summer-fall

√ Water Needs: Low

✓ Best Use: Large accent shrub, tropical desert contrast









Torch Glow Bougainvillea (Bougainvillea 'Torch Glow')

✓ Size: 6-8 ft tall, 3-4 ft wide

✓ Foliage: Dark green, upright habit

✓ Flowers: Magenta bracts, year-round color in warm climates

√ Water Needs: Low

✓ Best Use: Vertical accent, sculptural form, patio focal point



Ornamental Grasses & Perennials

Perfect for softening hardscapes and adding movement.

Regal Mist (Muhlenbergia capillaris 'Regal Mist')

✓ Size: 3-4 ft tall and wide

✓ Foliage: Fine, arching green blades✓ Flowers: Airy pink-red plumes in fall

√ Water Needs: Low

✓ Best Use: Mass plantings, soft texture contrast

Mealy Cup Sage (Salvia farinacea)

✓ Size: 2-3 ft tall, 2-3 ft wide

✓ Foliage: Green-gray, slightly fuzzy

✓ Flowers: Blue-purple spikes, spring-fall

√ Water Needs: Low

✓ Best Use: Pollinator plant, soft accent in rock gardens





Ground Covers & Sprawling Plants

Use these for erosion control, color drifts, and soft transitions.

Verbena (Glandularia species)

✓ Size: 1-2 ft tall, spreading to 4 ft ✓ Foliage: Low, green, fine-textured

✓ Flowers: Purple, pink, or red clusters, nearly year-round

√ Water Needs: Low

√ Best Use: Ground cover, container plant

Desert Mallow (Sphaeralcea ambigua)

✓ Size: 3-4 ft tall, 3-5 ft wide

✓ Foliage: Silver-gray, small lobed leaves✓ Flowers: Orange blooms in spring-fall

√ Water Needs: Low

✓ Best Use: Wildflower accent, color contrast

Mexican Evening Primrose (Oenothera berlandieri)

✓ Size: 1-2 ft tall, spreading up to 5 ft

√ Foliage: Green, delicate leaves

✓ Flowers: Pink cup-shaped blooms in spring-summer

√ Water Needs: Low

✓ Best Use: Spreading ground cover, cottage-style desert planting







Plumbago (Plumbago auriculata)

✓ Size: 3-4 ft tall, 4-6 ft spread

✓ Foliage: Deep green, dense growth

✓ Flowers: Soft blue clusters, summer-fall

✓ Water Needs: Moderate

✓ Best Use: Flowering hedge, tropical-style contrast

Blue Periwinkle (Vinca major)

✓ Size: 1-2 ft tall, 3-6 ft spread

✓ Foliage: Glossy green, trailing habit

✓ Flowers: Purple-blue blooms in spring-summer

✓ Water Needs: Moderate

✓ Best Use: Shaded ground cover, erosion control

Red Lantana (Lantana camara 'Radiation')

✓ Size: 2-3 ft tall, 3-5 ft spread

✓ Foliage: Dark green, rough-textured

✓ Flowers: Red-orange clusters, summer-fall

√ Water Needs: Low

✓ Best Use: Heat-tolerant ground cover, butterfly attractor

Purple Trailing Lantana (Lantana montevidensis)

✓ Size: 1-2 ft tall, spreading up to 6 ft

√ Foliage: Green, cascading stems

✓ Flowers: Lavender-purple, nearly year-round

√ Water Needs: Low

✓ Best Use: Ground cover, hanging basket, erosion control









Additional Ground Covers

(These are currently not on the LAC planting list)

Kurapia (Lippia nodiflora 'Kurapia')

- ✓ Size: 1-3 inches tall, spreading up to 6 feet per year
- ✓ Foliage: Small, dense green leaves, evergreen in warm climates
- ✓ Flowers: Tiny white blooms from spring to fall
- √ Water Needs: Very low once established
- ✓ **Soil Requirements:** Well-draining soils; tolerates a range of soil types
- ✓ Sun Requirements: Full sun to partial shade
- ✓ **Drought Tolerance: Excellent**—stays green with minimal irrigation
- ✓ Traffic Tolerance: High—can handle foot traffic and pets
- ✓ Maintenance:
 - Mowing: Optional; mow every 4-6 weeks for a turf-like appearance
 - Fertilization: Minimal—1-2 times per year
 - Weed Control: Establishment phase requires some weeding, but forms a dense mat over time

Carpet of Stars (Ruschia lineolata 'Nana')

- ✓ Size: 1-2 inches tall, spreading up to 1 foot per year
- ✓ Foliage: Small, tight-growing, succulent-like leaves that stay lush green year-round
- ✓ Flowers: Tiny purple-pink blooms in spring and summer (adds seasonal color)
- ✓ Water Needs: Very low once established (requires 70-80% less water than grass)
- ✓ Soil Requirements: Well-draining soil (tolerates sandy, rocky, or loamy soils)
- ✓ Sun Requirements: Full sun to partial shade (performs best with 6+ hours of sun)
- ✓ **Drought Tolerance: Exceptional**—survives with minimal irrigation
- ✓ Traffic Tolerance: Moderate to high—best for light foot traffic (not as resilient as Kurapia for heavy play areas)
- ✓ Maintenance:
 - Mowing: Not required—remains short and dense naturally
 - Fertilization: Occasional feeding in spring for faster growth
 - Weed Control: Establishment phase requires some weeding, but once mature, it suppresses weeds well





Cacti & Succulents (Architectural Plants)

Sculptural, low-maintenance focal points for a Desert Modern look.

Peruvian Apple Cactus (Cereus peruvianus)

✓ Size: 10-20 ft tall, 6-10 ft wide

✓ Foliage: Columnar, bluish-green stems

✓ Flowers: Large white night-blooming flowers, edible fruit

√ Water Needs: Very low

✓ **Best Use:** Statement cactus, contemporary accent

Parry's Agave (Agave parryi)

✓ Size: 2-3 ft tall, 3-4 ft wide

✓ Foliage: Blue-gray rosette, stiff leaves

✓ Flowers: Tall flower spike (once in lifetime)

√ Water Needs: Very low

✓ Best Use: Sculptural accent, modern planter feature

Red Yucca (Hesperaloe parviflora)

✓ Size: 3-4 ft tall, 3-5 ft wide

✓ Foliage: Narrow, arching blue-green leaves

✓ Flowers: Coral-red spikes in summer

√ Water Needs: Very low

✓ Best Use: Architectural form, poolside planting
