- Occupancy Updates: Notify the HOA immediately if there is a change in residency, whether temporary or permanent, including when ownership transitions due to incapacity or passing of a primary owner. Please contact a Board Member, send an email, or mail a written notice to the HOA's address.
- **Parking Regulations:** Vehicles must not obstruct sidewalks, whether parked in driveways or on the street. Please remind family members, visitors, and service providers of this rule. Additionally, vehicles may not be parked on gravel areas adjacent to driveways.
- **Pet Courtesy:** Dog walkers, please ensure any displaced gravel from your pet's activities is swept back into place.
- **Trash Collection:** Trash receptacles should be placed outside no earlier than late afternoon or early evening before collection day and must be returned inside the garage or stored behind the A/C compressor after pickup.
- **Newspaper Pick-Up:** Any newspapers delivered to your driveway should be retrieved the same day or by the following morning, regardless of whether you intend to read them.
- Street Parking Etiquette: If you must park on the street, ensure your vehicle is positioned in the direction of traffic flow and does not encroach upon the sidewalk.
