


Men's wellbeing is a growing community concern.

Ashley Cain is a former professional footballer, Ex on the Beach reality star, endurance athlete, and childhood cancer campaigner. Following the loss of his daughter, Azaylia, he founded The Azaylia Foundation, fundraising nearly £200,000 and breaking records with a coast-to-coast Ultraman challenge to drive change and awareness. His journey transforms grief into powerful advocacy, resilience, and purpose—making his keynote deeply resonate with themes of strength, mental health, and community building.
