## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

Stallion must be nominated or their breeding must be sold through the ApCHA Stallion Service Auction. Bidding for stallion will start at \$350.00 in the stallion auction. Stallion Nomination Fee is \$350.00 or ½ of the advertised breeding fee, whichever is greater. A stallion can be nominated after the stallion service auction ends, but will be charged a 25% Late Fee based on the advertised breeding fee the year the auction was held. Once a stallion is nominated or breeding purchased through the auction, additional foals can be nominated in order to be eligible for incentive money. Stallion owner can pay nomination fee and will receive a foal nomination, do not have their stallion service auctioned off, and additional foals would be eligible to nominate.
