

Membership Rules and Courtesies

General

- Membership includes the member, his/her spouse and his/her dependent children.
- Season is May 1st through October 31st yearly.
- Maximum of four (4) fishing guests per membership are allowed on club property.
- Members & guests MUST display badges on outermost garments while fishing.
- Members & guests MUST display vehicle cards in all vehicles and campers.
- No vehicles are allowed on dams or maintenance roads.
- Guests MUST be accompanied by members while on club property.
- Giving the gate code to non-members may result in your suspension from the club.
- Only kick powered pontoons & belly boats are allowed on the water. No kayaks.
- No live bait allowed. Worms, minnows, corn and chumming are NOT allowed.
- Fires must be built in designated fire pits only.
- Do NOT clean your fish in the lakes. You may use the stream outside the main gate.
- Fish limits are Colorado state limits.
- Only two (2) fish per day are allowed to be kept from the upper lake.
- Guests are allowed half (½) of member allowed limits.
- Please pick up fishing line & litter.
- No diapers, trash, cans, bags, etc. in the portable toilets.

Cards, Badges (Pins) and Gate Combination

- Members will have their membership card in their possession at all times.
- Members will wear their member pins at all times on their outermost garment.
- Members are not allowed to reproduce cards or pins.
- Members are not allowed to share the gate combination to non-members.

Fishing – Member

- All Colorado Division of Wildlife laws will be followed.
- Fishing license(s) are required.
- No member will take more than four (4) fish on any one day.
- Members may only have one (1) rod in the water at any one time.
- Fishing rods must be under the control of the fisherman.
- Hours for fishing begin one hour before sunrise and end one hour after sunset.
- NO: ice fishing is allowed; NO live bait is allowed; NO cleaning fish in lakes or streams.
- The Upper Lake will be open to bait fishing ONLY AT THE DAM.
- Upper lake limit is two (2) fish limit per member (1 fish per quest).



Membership Rules and Courtesies (Continued)

Guests

- A membership (not each member) may be accompanied by up to four (4) fishing guests at any one time.
- For adult guests who fish, a fee of \$10.00 per day will be deposited in a guest registration & payment envelope just inside the gate.
- Guest fees shall be paid PRIOR to the guest being permitted to fish.
- For guests aged 10-14 who fish, a fee of \$5.00 per day will be paid in a similar manner.
- Guests will be accompanied by the member at all times.
- Guests will wear their guest pins at all times on their outermost garment.
- Rules for guests are same as those for a member with the following additions:
- No guest will keep more than two fish on any one day; guests may keep only one fish from the upper lake.

Vehicles, Pets, Camping and Club Property

- Only belly boats and kick powered pontoon craft are allowed.
- No kayaks, motorized boats, or swimming allowed.
- Pets must be kept on a leash and cannot go into the water.
- Camping and campfires are allowed in designated areas only.
- Campfires must be completely extinguished if campers are not present.
- All tangled fishing lines must be removed from the property.
- Please help keep the area pristine by picking up any litter or debris you encounter!
- Firearms may not be discharged on TFC property.
- Motorcycles and ATVs shall be permitted for transportation on improved roads only.
- All motorized vehicles must stay on trails and in parking areas.
- Vehicles may not be driven to the water shore or on the dam maintenance roads.
- Campers are allowed to be parked on the facility between May 1st and October 31st.
- Campers and tents may not be left at a campsite unoccupied overnight.
- Campers must display the owner's name and contact information; additional parking placards may be requested for this purpose.
- No cutting of trees allowed.
- No mining and/or taking of gravel allowed.
- Bears members are encouraged to not leave ice chests outside unattended; lock coolers inside vehicles or campers.
