These forms are important to us for funding\* as well as to ensure we have your up-to-date contact information. \*we rely on a variety of funding to continue offering programs at no charge to the public age 50+.
- The Department of Health has increased our capacity limits. You'll see some activities increasing in size a bit, however, most of the time we will keep our numbers low to ensure everyone's comfort and safety.
