CONVERSION & CALL

I was blessed to be raised in a home where my parents made Jesus Christ and the church a central part of our lives. At the age of 9, I became aware of my sin and experienced the conviction of the Holy Spirit. My parents and a friend made clear the gospel and that's when I looked to Jesus, repented of my sin, and placed my trust in Christ alone for my salvation. I was baptized not long after.

It wasn't until I was in seminary that I realized God's call on my life to pastoral ministry. I had known since college that I wanted to be in Christian ministry and had even worked at a church for 2 summers during college and Summit Ministries, a para-church ministry, for 6+ years after college. But I had not wanted to be a pastor because of the examples of pastoral ministry I had seen demonstrated while growing up in a traditional Southern Baptist church in East Tennessee. All the discipleship I had ever been a part of happened outside the local church. In many ways I was loved very well and was most certainly taught Bible stories. But I had not been in a church where pastors taught the Bible expositionally, made disciples, and equipped the church to do the

same. I had only experienced pastors who ran programs, events, and preached sermons that were only loosely connected to the Scripture.

That was until God convicted me and showed me that discipleship was at the heart of the the Great Commission that HE gave to His church! For many years people who knew me had born witness to my calling to be a pastor, and told me that they thought I was going to be a pastor. But I would not hear it because of my misunderstanding of pastoral ministry. I would not waste my life being a Pastor when so many people who professed to be Christians didn't read or understand the Bible and what it teaches about following Jesus! It was during seminary that I saw what the Bible teaches about the role of pastors/elders/overseers and realized that being a pastor was exactly what I desired to do with my life. My family, church family, and the pastors at Johnson Ferry Baptist Church also bore witness to and affirmed God's call on my life to pastoral ministry as well as my character and competence to answer that calling.
