## 1. TRUCKING LIVES SAMPLE VERSUS HGV DRIVER POPULATION ESTIMATES AS PER ONS DATA

The Trucking Lives survey did not seek a sample that was representative of the UK HGV driver population. This is because the aim of the survey was to understand the experiences of all types of HGV drivers, including those

currently under-represented (women, ethnic minorities, younger drivers). A representative sampling strategy would not have provided us with sufficient respondents within these demographic groups to be able to accurately represent their experiences. Nevertheless, in many ways, our sample does have similarities to the population. Below we compare the Trucking Lives survey sample to the UK HGV driver population data.
