## WHAT WE DID IN 2022

The citizens of Carbon County continue to benefit from CCLF funding, and the services our libraries offer. We provide 95% of all programming funds, including movie licensing fees for all eight branches. The foundation has outfitted each branch with necessary furniture and equipment to further enhance library operations. This includes new public computers, business station equipment, Makerspace machinery, and Libby and Overdrive subscriptions. This allow our patrons to enjoy e-books, magazines and audio books at no cost.

Carbon County librarians continue to receive scholarships and Wyoming Library Association memberships. WYLD consortium fees enable Wyomingites in the smallest communities to gain access to a vast array of library resources. We are proud to support the new community outreach booth which promotes library services and connects us the wonderful people of Carbon County.

Carbon County has 3,460 active library users and our libraries have circulated 48,794 items between 2021 and 2022
