CHECK IN AND INSPECTION: Check In will occur on a rolling basis throughout the day. The two FAST CAT® Tests each day will be run **CONCURRENTLY**, so a dog entered in both Tests will run twice within an hour or so. Check In is immediately followed by inspection for fitness, lameness, or “in season” females. Each female dog will be inspected. The dog owner will be required to wipe the dog with a tissue to show the dog is not in season.

Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The inspection committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test and, in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded. At roll call, dogs may be measured by a wicket to verify handicaps.

Bitches in season, lame and unfit dogs will be excused with entry refunded. Please do not bring bitches in season to the test.

Pre-Entry Fee: \$28.00, per dog, per trial.

Day of Entry Fee: \$33.00, per dog, per trial.

Your entry fee includes FREE parking and FREE admission to the Fair.

On Site Parking

There is **limited free parking** – **carpooling is strongly encouraged**. No RV overnight parking is allowed. The Stable Gate will open at 9:00 AM, daily. The cost of parking is included in your entry fee. You must park in the designated area specified by the Fair. **ALL** vehicles must leave the grounds daily, prior to 11:00 PM. Vehicles left overnight will be towed without warning and at the owner's sole expense.

On Site Food Vendor

The Fair will be in full operation from 11:00 AM until 11:00 PM, daily. There are numerous food vendors throughout the facility, with several in close proximity to the arena.

Weather Event Policy

"In case of dangerous or doubtful weather conditions, the Trial Chair will notify the Trial Secretary of cancellations or schedule changes by 7:00 AM on the day of the trial. The Trial Secretary will then notify all entrants via email to the change in schedule. In the event of all trials being canceled, checks will be shredded. If only some trials are canceled at these events, refunds will be issued."

A flat LIGHT blue ribbon for a passing qualifying run. Rosettes will be offered for those attaining a FAST CAT® title.

What must my dog do to pass a FAST CAT®?

FAST CAT®, unlike the CAT, is not a pass/fail, but a timed 100-yard dash chasing a lure past a start line and over a finish line. Break Beam Timers will be used. If the timers become inoperable, we have stop watches as a backup system. The time is converted to MPH and then multiplied by a potential handicap based on the dog's height to award points.

We will be using a continuous loop lure. The FAST CAT® Track and run out are fully fenced. The Lure will run down the center of the track and will return without obstructing the exit.

Can my dog earn an AKC title for FAST CAT®?

Titles are earned by accumulating points. The following titles will be awarded: BCAT = 150 points; DCAT = 500 points; FCAT = 1,000 points; and FCAT followed by a number (e.g. FCAT2) for every additional 500 points. These suffix titles will appear on a dog's pedigree, with a higher-level title superseding a lower-level title.

What is the FAST CAT®?

FAST CAT® is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs.

Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced, and dogs are run individually.

The time is converted to miles per hour (MPH).

Formula:

$$204.545/\text{RUNTIME} = \text{MPH}$$

Based on the dog's size at the withers, a handicap is applied to calculate points earned:

18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0

12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.

Under 12" = Handicap is 2.0 (*rounded to nearest 0.01*)

Formula:

$$\text{MPH} \times \text{HANDICAP} = \text{POINTS}$$

Titles are earned at specific point levels and the highest suffix may appear after the dog's name:

BCAT = 150 points; **DCAT** = 500 points; **FCAT** = 1,000 points; **FCAT#** = Each additional 500 points

Top 20 by Breed by Year: The AKC FAST CAT® website will feature the Top 20 fastest dogs by breed. Dogs must complete at least three (3) qualifying runs in each calendar year to qualify for the Top 20. The standings will be updated as event results are processed at https://www.apps.akc.org/apps/fastcat_ranking/

According to AKC rules: Handlers are not permitted to run with a dog during an official run but must remain either at the start or finish area of the course. Handlers are not to allow dogs to be enticed through the course with anything other than the lure during its official run. **NO mechanical devices** including whistles, horns, bull horns, etc. or toys, including the waving of objects to lure the dog to the finish line are allowed. You MAY CHEER and use the dog's name.

Be prompt at the start line when your number is called. It is best to have one person release your dog and have the primary owner calling and catching the dog at the finish line in the catch area.

Be sure to "warm up" your dog prior to your run. It is equally important to give your dog a "cool down" walk after the run. This will add to the health and well-being of your dog.

Collar Rules:

Dogs may run without a collar or wear any type of collar except choker collars, spiked collars, electronic training collars or head collar. Collars should be snug. Hanging tags pose a safety concern and it is suggested that tags be secured to the collar with tape. Dogs may run muzzled if desired. Clips or rubber bands may be used to keep long hair from falling across the dog's field of vision.

NOTICES

All entrants must have a FAST CAT® partner who will either be responsible for releasing the dog at the start line or catching the dog in the catch pen. If an entrant acquires a volunteer on the day of the event, (either Dog Sports America Staff, Del Sur Kennel Club member or other entrant), those individuals or volunteers will not be held liable for the actions of the dog, to include:

1. Poor start
2. Inability to control or catch the dog at the finish. It is encouraged to have a FAST CAT® partner familiar with the dog to catch the dog to avoid anxiety.
3. Owners with overstimulated dogs who need assistance to the start line will be handled with special care. The Paddock and Huntsperson may request early entry, separation from the "wait" line, or special action necessary to allow for a safe run for the dog and for the safety of everyone in the "wait" line.
4. Dogs who pose control problems in the catch area may require special assistance. The lure operators will "hold the course" until the dog is safe and under control at the finish line.
5. All dogs should be "warmed up" before running, which means a good 5-minute walk after leaving the car **BEFORE** running, and "cooled down" after running, which means a good 5-to-10-minute walk before entering the car.

ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK

This is a rain-or-shine event. Please plan accordingly.

All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply. All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test. Please bring your own chairs and water. On site bathrooms are available on both sides of the arena. No personal canopies will be allowed in the arena or parking lots. No x-pens will be allowed, only crates.

You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and children. Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running. You must provide two sturdy leashes (not show or flexi); one to hold your dog and one to catch your dog. Please arrange for someone to either catch or release your dog since you cannot be in two different places 100 yards apart. There may be dog holders/releasers, known as slippers, at the staging area. Be sure your dog can be caught at the end of the course.

A fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing, or an exhibitor caught not picking up after their dog. Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. Entry fees will be refunded.

Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC. Children must be under control of their parent(s) or guardian(s) at all times.

Neither Del Sur Kennel Club, nor its members or volunteers, Dog Sports America, the 22nd District Agricultural Association, the State of California, their officers, agents, servants, employees, will be held responsible for any accidents at these tests. The field committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.

NO ONE will be allowed on the field without the express permission of the event chairman, except the appointed event committee. Anybody exhibiting unsportsmanlike behavior will be excused from the field and may be subject to further disciplinary action.

There will be a \$5 fine assessed for any loose dog not taking part in the course in progress, or for anybody caught not picking up after their dog or for leaving garbage on the field.

By being present at this event, you agree to indemnify and save harmless Del Sur Kennel Club, its members and volunteers, Dog Sports America, 22nd District Agricultural Association and the State of California, their officers, agents, servants and employees from any and all claims, causes of action and suits accruing or resulting from any damage, injury or loss to any person or persons, including but not limited to loss of property, goods, wares or merchandise, caused by, arising out of or in any way connected with after this event.

The Del Sur Kennel Club has the right to cancel any event without notice at their discretion, due to inclement weather or unsafe conditions deemed to be an endangerment to the dogs or their owners.

AKC® Code of Sportsmanship and Civility

Preface: The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884—the year the American Kennel Club (AKC®) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years.

Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.
