



## The Problem We Can't Ignore

- India generates approximately 9.5 million tonnes of plastic waste annually.
- Over 60% of this consists of single-use plastics.
- Only around 60% of the plastic waste is collected and processed; the rest ends up in landfills, rivers, and oceans, causing severe environmental harm.
- An estimated 144 million plastic bottles are purchased every day in India for drinking water alone.
- While eliminating plastic production is not feasible, we can and must focus on reducing, reusing and recycling plastic to minimise impact.
