Treaty News Update

01 January 2020

We have maintained Treaties with Spain, France, England, and U.S. for five hundred years, which is 3 of the 5 permanent security council.

We have even a larger number of Ratified International Agreements with a number of member nations of the United Nations in the past couple of years with the expansion of our ministry of foreign affairs building globally relationships.

A number have these Ratified International Agreements have been entered into the United Nation to be filed and published under Article 102 of the UN Charter.

One third of all the treaties signed with native nations by the colonial nations were signed with the Cherokee Nation, to include the U.S.

Recently, we went through all of our treaties and found that many of the treaties by the U.S. were made by Fraud, Deception, Manipulation, Trickery, Coercion, Force and otherwise related, to include, but not limited to the treaties that illegally impeded or diminished the Sovereignty of our Nation, by which we are not bound to any treaty that is as such.

Further, we provided letters to the U.S. Secretary of State to inform the U.S. of many of these hundreds of years of treaties in violation, whereby the U.S. has broken these treaties and we have broken these treaties with executive orders, thus these treaties have been dissolved by both nations. What belonged to the nations prior these treaties are returned under international law.

The United Nation Secretary General was also notified of this treaty activity.

All other treaties with the U.S. that are in good standings remain, to include our trade agreement and ratified treaty of 1785 which marks our nations legal boundary and provides proper international ratified recognition.

All other ratified treaties in the past five hundred years with other member nations of United Nations remain.

All newly signed ratified international agreements with member nations of the United Nation remain.

All treaties of the NNIA remain in good standing.
