Since mid - 2014, the NNIA Treaty has been signed by tribal nations within the countries globally and by central/national, theocracies, domestic, regional, and local governments to include but not limited to Australia, Brazil, Bolivia, Canada, Colombia, DR Congo, Egypt, Ghana, Honduras, Iran, Israel, Malaysia, Mexico, Namibia, New Zealand, Nicaragua, Nigeria, Philippines, Royal Barotseland Government, SCNRFP, USA, Venezuela, Vietnam, Zambia, Eastern Orthodox Apostolic Church of the East (Sovereign Ecclesiastical State of the Church of the East), Sovereign Ecclesiastical State of the Church of the East, (Apostolic See), (Ecclesiastical Government), Ethiopian Tewahedo Church Theocracy Government, Jamaica, South Africa, Ecuador....

By 2010 a total of 137 Member Nations of the UN signed has signed the Declaration for Self-Determination, The Declaration is decades in the making, starting in with the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. The UDHR is a declaration adopted by the United Nations General Assembly on 10 December 1948.

Now comes the NNIA Treaty, a treaty of peace, good will, nation and community support and developing, trade and commerce, recognition and self-determination.

The NNIA Treaty supports the nations in a good way with the continued mission of making available economic development, social needs, technologies, and humanitarian efforts. We are making available education, medical, food-agriculture, housing, technologies, legal, and self-sustainable industries, businesses and otherwise to support a strong community and nation....

Companies incorporated within the State of SCNRFP have shown their desire to support the efforts of the NNIA and the State of SCNRFP state-owned (government) companies supports the

NNIA with providing the NNIA with the needed technologies, systems, services, products and monetary support.

The signing of the NNIA is available for governments to sign (tribal, central/national, theocracies, domestic, regional, and local)

Through the NNIA we are making available to the tribal nations of the NNIA members the same that is being offered to the member nations of the United Nations.

We Continue to Support Sovereignty and Self-Dependent Nations that desire becoming and maintaining a Peaceful Nation within a Global Community of Nations and Peoples.

The NNIA Convention was formed out of the NNIA Treaty. NNIA is headquartered within the Southern Cherokee Nation and The Red Fire People, State of SCNRFP (Sovereign Land).

The NNIA Treaty is for nation to nation continued peace and good will with one another, to maintain one's culture, heritage, traditions and way of life in a good way, to protect life, not diminish or impede sovereignty but rather embrace and protect sovereignty and self - determination, to properly recognize each other for the purpose of a strong and good relationship, complete holistic development through means of economic development, social needs, humanitarian, trade, legal protection, investments, funding, technologies, and to protect all life of creation.

The date of the treaty shall not be changed on the NNIA treaty, however, upon signing you will use the current date of signing date beside your signature.
