The Gladstone Park Neighborhood Association is proud to present its' 2019 scholarship. The scholarship is \$500 awarded to a Gladstone Park student who will be attending college or trade school in the fall of 2019.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants must be 19 years of age or younger and a high school graduate or a senior in high school during the 2018-2019 school year.
- Applicant must live in Gladstone Park (boundary map attached).
- Applicant must submit a completed application to the Gladstone Park Neighborhood Association by **February 25, 2019**.

Selection Criteria:

Applicants will be judged on a 500 word essay on a topic chosen by the Gladstone Park Neighborhood Association Scholarship committee.

The winner of the scholarship will be announced on **March 28, 2019**.

Application Instructions:

Application must include:

- A completed application form
- A copy of the applicant's drivers' license, state ID, or another form of identification verifying the applicant's residency.
- A copy of the applicant's letter of acceptance from the university, college, or trade school indicating the applicant's acceptance into a program of study in the fall of 2019.
- A copy of the applicant's most recent report card with cumulative GPA.
- A personal reference (not from a family member) (form attached).
- A 500 word essay (topic to be provided on attached form).

Boundary Map

Eligible applicants must live within the boundaries of the Gladstone Park Neighborhood Association and provide proof of residency.

The Gladstone Park Neighborhood Association boundaries begin at Nagle and Devon Avenues as the far Northwest corner of the boundaries, EAST to the North Branch of the Chicago River, then SOUTHEAST to Central Avenue, then SOUTH to Northwest Highway, then NORTHWEST to Bryn Mawr Avenue, then WEST to Nagle Avenue, then NORTH to Devon Avenue. Gladstone Park Neighborhood Association boundaries include all residents on both sides of the street of defined borders.
