REGULATIONS COVERING SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

1. Application must be completely filled out and signed by applicant, Proposer and two Seconding members.
2. Application, accompanied by application fee appropriate to proposed classification, will then be submitted to the Secretary of the Club.
3. The Secretary or any Committee appointed by the President of the Club may contact the Applicant at their discretion in writing or by telephone.
4. Application will be processed in accordance with Club By-Laws.
5. Upon application approval, Applicant must pay fees prescribed for admission to membership.

Plum Brook Country Club was founded on January 29, 1914, when five charter members signed the Articles of Incorporation of The Sandusky Golf Club. The following statement was included: "The purpose is to promote golf and other athletic sports, to encourage outdoor exercise, and to promote sociability among its members and others; to rent, own and maintain real estate and buildings for its purpose; and to do all things necessary and incident thereto." George C. Steinemann was the Club's first President.

A nine hole golf course was established at the northeast corner of South Hayes Avenue and Strub Road. The course opened July 4, 1914, and it soon became apparent that the course was unsatisfactory – the terrain was flat, without any water hazards, and not sporting enough. A committee appointed by the Board of Trustees sought and found a new site occupying 55 acres at the northeast corner of Galloway and Hull Roads, our present location. The gently rolling land with Plum Brook winding through it was purchased in 1916 for \$350 per acre and the Club's name was changed to Plum Brook Country Club.

Bertie Way, a Cleveland Golf Professional, was hired to design and lay out the original nine holes, which were opened for play in 1917. Ground was broken for a new clubhouse on the present site in 1921 and replaced the previously used temporary structures. The clubhouse was completed in 1922 and many additions, changes and improvements have been made since then. The Club acquired additional land in the late 1920s and the existing course was modified and expanded to 18 holes in 1929. It, too, has been changed and upgraded to its present standing as one of the finest courses in the region.

Many notable golfers including Walter Hagen, Bryon Nelson, Ben Hogan, Sam Snead, Jimmy Demaret, and Plum Brook Honorary Member Frank Beard have played on and spoken well of our course. The Club currently hosts the Ohio Senior Hall of Fame Championship and is the permanent home of the Ohio Golf Hall of Fame.

Plum Brook is a family club offering many social activities, great golf, swimming, fine dining, and relaxation for all. Enjoy!
