THE FIRST STEPS

OUR LADY OF THE HAMPTONS PRE-SCHOOL at St. Rosalie's Parish Center

A full (or half) day program of Religion, prereading, math and science is combined with social skill development, dramatic play, arts and crafts. Classes are taught by licensed professional teachers who stress preparation for the elementary curriculum to follow. An outdoor playground is used daily. Field trips enhance learning.

THE PRIMARY COMMUNITY
