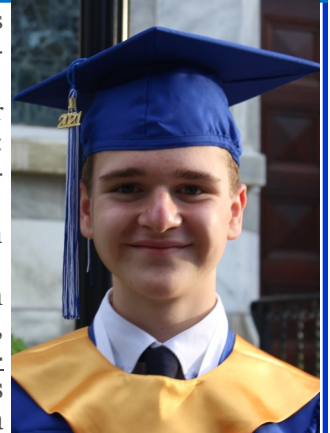


It seemed fitting, then, that this was the largest graduating class in the school's history with thirty-nine students.



SOME AWARDS ARE SPECIAL

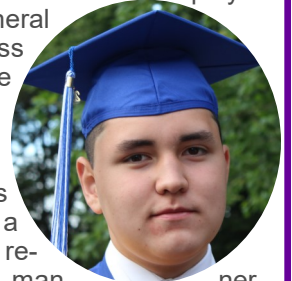
