1. Is the new grant for one year or two years?

The grant is a one-year grant but the selection of the CE/HARA is for five years at set forth in the CoC charter. There will be an opportunity to do a performance review every year.

2. The goal is to have both of these housed in same agency, right?

Yes, it is a combined RFP.

3. So Catholic Charities has been the HARA for five years?

Catholic Charities took over the CE/HARA from Shelter of Flint in March 2020.

4. What exactly can the grants be spent on?

That will depend on what HUD and MSHDA allow. Regarding Coordinated Entry, eligible costs include those directly related to providing supportive services as outlined in the CoC Interim Rule ([view here](#)), which are specifically designed to assist participants in securing and keeping housing.

5. How would the current hotline number transfer to a new organization?

The number can be ported over to the new organization via an agreement signed by the current owner.
