The cost for the trip including bus transportation and lunch is \$75/person. Lunch will be served at the Warden's Table. The Warden's Table restaurant offers a variety of southern food. Our meal will include: smoked pulled pork with a side of cole slaw and bbq sauce served over corn cakes. Additional sides include green beans and macaroni and cheese.
