



## Who this is for

Independent schools, colleges and universities with large grounds where fox activity is causing turf damage, fouling, denning, callouts, or creating health and safety (H&S) and maintenance risk.

## Typical site impacts

- Turf damage to pitches, lawns, fine turf and training areas.
- Denning and holes near boundaries, banks, retaining walls, sheds and outbuildings (trip and H&S risk).
- Fouling and odour around walkways, bin stores, service yards and perimeter areas.
- Damage to irrigation lines, cabling, lighting, sports equipment, astro turf, and soft landscaping.

## Safeguarding-led delivery (how risk is controlled)

- **Pre-visit planning:** scope, boundaries, neighbours, access, safe lines, and timing agreed with your site lead.
- **Documentation:** RAMS and insurance provided as required; method agreed before attendance.
- **Site control:** sign-in/out, site induction, designated point of contact, agreed working areas.
- **Discretion:** low-profile conduct, clear communications, minimal on-site footprint.
- **Out-of-hours delivery:** early morning/evening/weekends to reduce pupil and staff exposure and disruption.
- **Post-visit reporting:** brief written update (actions taken, observations, recommendations).
