Baking Corner

This time we brought you another great and proven recipe from Liana. Liana used to make dog cookies based on recipe books and eventually created her own. Her dogs think these cookies are ***barkalicious!***

Barkalicious Peanut Butter Banana Cookies

1 ½ cup oat flour
1 ½ cup brown rice flour
½ cup natural unsalted peanut butter
1 banana
1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
1 egg
1 tablespoon honey
½ cup water

Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

Combine all ingredients (except water) together.

Add water slowly and mix until a dough forms (if too dry, add more water, too wet, add a bit more flour).

Roll out on a lightly floured surface to a ¼" thickness.

Use a cookie cutter to cut into shapes.

Line a cookie sheet with parchment paper (for easy clean up) and place the cookies on the sheet (they can be rather close together as they don't grow much while cooking).

Bake 20-25 minutes or until golden brown.

Transfer and let cool completely on a wire rack.

Store the cookies in an airtight container in the refrigerator to keep them freshest.
