

Entry Fee

\$25.00 per entry per dog per test (Includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee)

Day of Test entries are \$30.00 for each entry, and will close 30 minutes prior to roll call at the Field Trial Secretary's table. Day of Test entries accepted as space allows. If the trial has not filled, day of show entries will be accepted until 8:00AM. Closing date is October 12, 2019, no cancellations refunded after the closing date. All cancellations are subject to \$2.00 processing fee per entry. Incomplete, unsigned, or conditional entries will not be accepted. Entries are accepted online at sugarloafmountainracing.com or by USPS mail. Online entries are preferred with instant entry confirmation by email and will have an additional \$0.50 processing fee added per entry. All paper entries will be acknowledged by email if legible email address is provided in entry form.

Conditions of Entry

Dogs must have an AKC registration number and be at least one year of age on the day of the trial. Dogs may only run once per test. One dog per entry form. All entries must be accompanied with a check or online payment to be valid. A returned check is not a valid entry. Fast CAT events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate.

Hours

Grounds will be available at 8:00AM. This trial will have a rolling roll call, which means you check in at the paddock master station for inspection prior to running. SNSCSC/KSSC will make every attempt to facilitate that all entrants will be accommodated with regard to running their dogs in the trials, but it is also the responsibility of each entrant to make an effort to be ready when their dog is called to the line. Trials will begin at 9:00AM until all runs are completed, with a break for lunch at the conclusion of the morning trial.

<u>Prizes</u>

SNJCSC/KSSC will offer a light blue flat ribbon for a passing qualifying run.

SNJCSC/KSSC will have a limited number of title rosettes available. Please notify the trial secretary, via email or include with your entry form, if you will be earning the following titles to ensure that the club will have rosettes available.

What is the Fast CAT?

Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs. Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced and dogs are run individually. Dogs are timed when they complete the 100-yard dash. The time is converted to Miles Per Hour (MPH). Based on the dog's size at the withers a handicap is applied and points are earned:

- 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.
- Below 12" = Handicap is 2.0.

MPH X HANDICAP = POINTS

Titles are earned at specific point levels and the highest suffix may appear after the dog's name:

BCAT = 150 points DCAT = 500 points FCAT = 1,000 points FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

Trial Site Directions

From Route 287

Southbound: Route 287 South to Exit 17 (Routes 202/206 South). When the highways split, take 202 South for two miles and make a right onto Milltown Road. North Branch Park is on the left.

Northbound: Route 287 North to Exit 14B Route 22 West. Take Exit 202/206 South. When the highways split, take 202 South for two miles and make a right onto Milltown Road. North Branch Park is on the left.

From Route 22

Westbound: Follow Route 22 West to Route 202/206 South. After a half mile, the highways split. Take Route 202 South. Approximately 2 miles down Route 202, you will then travel under a train overpass. Make a right at the next turn onto Milltown Road. Travel a half mile, and North Branch Park will be on the left.

Eastbound: Follow Route 22 East through Branchburg. Make a right turn onto Milltown Road. Follow Milltown Road for 1 mile and bear right under the railroad trestle. North Branch Park will be on the right.

From 206

Northbound: Follow Route 206 until the Somerville Circle. Exit off of the circle onto Route 202 south. Approximately 2 miles down Route 202, you will travel under a train overpass. Make a right at the next turn onto Milltown Road. Travel a half mile, and North Branch Park will be on the left.

From Route 78 Westbound: Follow Route 78 West to Route 287 South. Then follow the above directions for Route 287 South. Eastbound: Follow Route 78 East to Route 22 East. Then follow the above directions for Route 22 East.

Notice To All Exhibitors

All exhibitors must be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs on the motel, RV and trial grounds. Motels require that dogs be crated when unattended. Any damages to motels, RV sites or the trial site can result in disciplinary action by the Event Committee. It is expected that exhibitors will clean up immediately after their own dogs and strongly encourage others to do the same. All owners/exhibitors should be aware that the entire motel grounds and RV sites are considered within the trial grounds. You will be responsible for all damage to your room/site and may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the rules of the AKC. Any abuse of the grounds will be brought to the attention of the trial-giving club and its Event Committee. Any exhibitor's entries may be refused for previous misuse of the motel or RV facilities. This is an AKC supported measure.

Trial Information

- SNJCSC/KSSC reserve the right to refuse entry.
- Please pick up after your dog so we can continue to use this wonderful park. Any exhibitor caught not cleaning up after their dog will be asked to leave the trial grounds. No refund will be given if this occurs. A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing.
- Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running.
- ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK.
- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.
- This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly. Please bring your own shade, chairs and water.
- An electronic timing system will be used. An electric, continuous loop, plastic strip lure machine will be used.
- The show grounds are not completely fenced. The FAST CAT course will be fenced.
- On site indoor bathrooms are available.
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running.
- You are responsible for controlling your dogs and children.
- Each dog requires an individual entry. You may use one form to enter one dog for all events. Use the checkbox and mark off each event you wish to enter, \$25.00 per entry.
- The huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve the dog on the course.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to the AKC/SNJCSC/KSSC/any dog(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site by the Field Committee, maybe disciplined by the AKC, and **entry fees will not be refunded**.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club or the event-hosting club.
