We would like to inform your office about our current policy regarding Physical Therapy treatment in our office:

We are currently open for in-office visits for NEW patients. Our plan is to provide care for essential patients in the clinic at this time, whether they are post-op or have a new injury, and then transition these patients, if appropriate, to a telehealth program once a plan of care has been established by our PT department.

Our office has been providing telehealth treatments to patients since the beginning of the COVID-19 crisis, and we will continue to do so for patients who have an established plan of care or for those who may be more comfortable remaining at their homes for visits during the pandemic.

Strict safety procedures are in place per CDC recommendations:

- All patients will wear masks and follow proper hand washing/sanitizing protocols
- All equipment is thoroughly disinfected, and all linens are cleaned with each patient interaction
- All patients will be screened for symptoms before each visit
- Our schedule has been adjusted to limit workflow and capacity of the clinic

Finally, I would like to personally thank all of you for the extra effort and changes I am sure you have been made over the last 2 months; this has and will continue to be a challenging time for all of us. I look forward to the time in the near future when we return to being able to help and provide care for all of those who need us.
