Instructions for MEN'S SIZE CAP

Cast-on (104) sts

Knit ribbing using #5 or #6 needle, k1, p1, or k2, p2

Either: 1 - 1.5 inches

or 3.5 inches (if fold-over desired)

Knit row using same color to Increase stitches
as below*

For body of cap, change to #7 or #8 needle

Use Chart A for body

After completing row 30, use chart B to

decrease to form top of cap

When completed w/ row 46 pull yarn thru all

stitches and finish by working in loose ends inside cap

Add pom pom to top if desired

*Increase stitches for body based on # cast-on

- if 104 stitches, increase to 120: Add 1 stitch

every 7.5 stitches

Instructions for WOMEN'S SIZE CAP

Cast-on (88) sts

Knit ribbing using **#5** or #6 needle, k1, p1, or k2, p2

Either: 1 - 1.5 inches

or 3.5 inches (if fold-over desired)

Knit row using same color to Increase stitches
as below*

For body of cap, change to **#6** needle

Use Chart A for body

After completing row 30, use chart B to

decrease to form top of cap

When completed w/ row 46 pull yarn thru all

stitches and finish by working in loose

ends inside cap

Add pom pom to top if desired

*Increase stitches for body based on # cast-on

- if 88 stitches, increase to 120: Add 1 stitch

every 3.75 stitches
