

Approved Clear Lake Township February 17, 2026, Board Meeting Minutes

February 17th, 2026, Clear Lake Township Board meeting was held at the Clear Lake Township Hall. Members present were Chairman Bud Stimmler, Vice Chair Ross Imholte, Supervisor Kiel Golly, Treasurer Paul Goenner, Road Engineer T. Chairman Bud Stimmler opened the meeting. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Motion by Ross Imholte, second by Kiel Golly to approve the agenda. Motion Passed.

Todd Schendzielos IUP Request for a manufactured home: Parker Schendzielos was present to discuss the plan to move in a manufactured home to be used by Todds mother-in-law that is within the Agricultural District and within the Natural Environment Shoreland District of Camp Lake and Eilers Lake. The Board will send in a favorable comment to the County.

Eilers Garden LLC” Solar IUP and a Comprehensive Land Use Plan Map Amendment at PID 20-00213-2200: Michael Braun was present explain the plan. Applicant answered all questions concerning a driveway permit and trees and he agreed to a chain link fence and to the financial agreement concerning the possible decommissioning of the solar garden. Motion by Ross Imholte to send a positive comment form, second by Kiel Golly. Carried.

Tana Thomson: 92nd St Road Order Discussion: They would like to purchase the property and split it into 3 lots for family members; but would need a road to be put in and were wondering if the Township would agree. The Township engineers checked into it and has found it would not be something that could be done.

ROAD REPORT: Still waiting to hear about the grant. There was some damage on 70th and 90th caused by the work done installing solar panels.

Chairmans Report: Discussed the May 2nd Clean up day and the March 10 annual meeting and election. There is a ballot question to move the Township elections to November.

Ross Imholte made a motion to adjourn, second by Kiel Golly. Motion carried. Adjourned at 7:45 pm
