

Approved Clear Lake Township January 20th, 2026, Board Meeting Minutes

January 20th, 2026, Clear Lake Township Board meeting was held at the Clear Lake Township Hall. Members present were Chairman Bud Stimmler, Vice Chair Ross Imholte, Supervisor Kiel Golly, Treasurer Paul Goenner, Road Engineer T. Vander Eyk, Clerk Nancy Betzler and Sgt Derek Baret.

Old Business:

County Comment Form: Proposed Ordinance for Veterinary Clinics in Ag land. The change would be an ordinance amendment to establish a new Interim Use Permit into Sherburne County for Veterinary clinics. Motion by Ross Imholte to approve, second by Kiel. Carried.

ROAD REPORT: Eyk gave a report on some of the changes that Sherburne County Planning & Zoning are considering.

Chairmans Report: There is some road damage on 90th Ave. Will try to find out how the damage happened.
