SHERIFF'S REPORT: The July monthly report was given, calls last year were 136 compared to 125 this year.

PARK & TRAILS REPORT: Playground and trails are being used daily, everything looking good.

<u>Old Business: Clean-up Day:</u> Treasurer gave an update of the cost after expenses were paid, there was a profit of \$304.87.

NEW BUSINESS:

<u>Sherburne County Soil and Water</u>: Miranda Wagner and Francine Larson were present to explain programs that are available for residents. There is funding to be used for shoreline stabilization, stormwater mitigation, native prairie, agricultural practices and for irrigation practices.

<u>Fire Board Report/ City of Clear Lake</u>: Members of the City Council and the Fire Department were present to discuss the new budget. Chairman Stimmler said he appreciated the hard work that has been done to prepare the budget and the cooperation while working together to complete it. Part of the increase is to be able to increase the salaries for the firefighters from \$12 to \$15 per hour and to save money each year for future equipment purchases. They will get the new budget each year to us in February so the Township has time to plan for the levy each year and will present a monthly report at the monthly meeting.

Resolution Designating the First Tuesday after the First Monday in November as the Town General Election Date: There were some concerns about the dates presented in the resolution, will be continued until our next meeting.

ROAD REPORT: Eyk gave everyone a report for White Farms Estates partial payment 3, not sure when we will be billed. The striping for the roads will be \$1800.00. Gave a copy of the road order for 95th Ave.
