June 17th, 2025, Board Meeting Minutes

Approved minutes of June 17th, 2025, the Clear Lake Township Board meeting held at the Clear Lake Township Hall.

Members present were Chairman Bud Stimmler, Supervisor Ross Imholte, Supervisor Kiel Golly, Treasurer Paul Goenner, Road Engineer T. Vander Eyk, and Deputy Clerk Gary Anderson. Others present were Chris & Rachael Iverson and Sergeant Derek Barrett.

The meeting was called to order by Chair Bud Stimmler. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Ross Imholte made a motion to approve the agenda, second by Kiel Golly. Carried.

The Supervisors reviewed the minutes of the regular township board meeting held on 05/20/2025. Motion to approve by Kiel Golly second by Ross Imholte. Carried.

After reviewing the bills presented, Kiel Golly motioned to pay the bills with a second by Ross Imholte. Motion carried.

SHERIFF'S REPORT: Sergeant Barrett was present to give the May 2025 monthly report, calls last year were 135 compared to 94 this year. There was a vehicle report and one school bus stop arm violation.

PARK & TRAILS REPORT: Everything is looking good. Still waiting for the new planting to be done. MN Greening will be doing a new planting.

NEW BUSINESS:

Rachael Iverson 7124 107th Ave SE. Variances for septic system. Chris Iverson explained the plan to replace their septic system. They need 3 variances to complete the system. Requesting a 10ft Variance from the Road Right of Way of 107th Ave SE to upgrade septic system, an 8ft variance to place a septic drain field 12ft from a dwelling (required setback is 20ft) and a 10 ft variance to the north property line to install a new septic system. The old system will be removed. Ross Imholte made a motion to approve all 3 variances, if the neighbors approve, second by Kiel Golly. Motion carried.

Proposed Amendment to Subdivision Ord.Sec.10-Standard Plat Sub.6-Final Plat Process. There will be a public hearing on June 26th. Ross Imholte made a motion to approve the memorandum, Kiel Golly second. Carried

ROAD REPORT

Update White Farms Estate Project: 3485 tons of asphalt was used; concert driveways will be poured tomorrow. Next week will be marking the mailbox support locations and by the end of next week the majority of the work should be done.

Letter to Clearview: Discuss the letter the Eyk has written to Clearview School requesting to make changes for picking up or dropping off students for school. Will be mailing the letter.

Chairmans Report: There are street signs that are missing and need to be replaced. Discussed if there is anything we can do to stop the thefts.

Bud will work with Central Applicators about the ditch spraying. Discussed some trees that should be removed.

Our Township 170th anniversary is next year.

Our Attorney is working on a resolution for moving the Township election from March to November.

Discussed hiring a new Deputy Clerk. Thanked Gary Anderson for his work as Deputy Clerk for many years.
