ROAD REPORT:

Eyk added some future project estimates for 70th Ave overlay for 2029. The bid for White Farm Estates project came in at \$303,795.96.

Eyk has written a letter to NEXTere Energy Resources expressing our concerns about the state of disrepair of a couple of their solar garden projects.

<u>Chairmans Report</u>: Reminder about the SCAT meeting tomorrow in Becker. They will be discussing the sirens that NSP had installed to use if there were problems at the Monticello nuclear plant. NSP is no longer wanting to provide them. The Township will have the opportunity to take over the expense for there upkeep.
