Ordinance of the Borough of Curwensville, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania Ordinance 499 of 2023

AN ORDINANCE OF CURWENSVILLE BOROUGH, CLEARFIELD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 485 TO MODIFY THE IMPOSITION OF TAX

NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained by the Borough of Curwensville, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same as follows:

- 1. Section 30-2. Imposition of tax; exemption, is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - §30-2. There is hereby imposed a tax, for general Borough purposes under the authority of the Borough Council, upon the privilege of using for profit within the Borough any vending machines, jukebox or mechanical amusement device which is installed or located for use. Such shall be payable by the person owning and/or operating the establishment in which such device is installed or located for use. Such tax for mechanical amusement devices, pool tables, jukeboxes, vending machines and service machines shall be \$100.00 for the calendar year or any portion thereof, plus \$100.00 for each additional machine. Nonprofit, church, fraternal organizations, and civic organizations shall be exempt from this tax.
- 2. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance or any Ordinance referenced which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are severable.
- 3. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid for any reason such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses or sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, sentence, clause, section or part thereof, not been included herein.

4. This Ordinance shall become effective January 1, 2024.
