### Men's Club Update

We want to thank everyone for their participation in our leaf program and clean up around the park. Most of our snowbirds have gone North and we will be taking a break for the Summer. The Leaf clean up program has been working very well. We will continue that in to the next year.

Thank you to Bruce Price for removing the 2 dead trees and planting 2 new trees by the pond area. There are plans to do more planting in the future. We will keep everyone up to date regarding that.

Thank you also to Jim Brandt for helping Bill out with the mowing during the busy summer.

#### **Budget Update YTD**

The board would like to keep you updated on items affecting our budget and where we expect issues so we can be aware as this year continues.

First of all, the National Weather Service has predicted the upcoming hurricane season will be more severe this year just based on the sheer number of expected storms. We have been proactive in preparing for, and responding to, tree issues in the park. We had a company who has done tree work in the park previously, High Trim, produce a "map" of the CEROC trees so we can be aware of possible problems we might face in the future. We are actively pursuing a tree maintenance program to trim, or remove, on a quarterly basis some of the problem areas we have been made aware of. Of course, we will remain diligent on adhering to the budget restraints as much as possible, but will respond appropriately to emergency situations.

As a shareholder, the trees on your property are still your responsibility, so please be aware of any issues you may have and prepare for them.

Our number one priority for the remainder of this year is the passage of the re-certification of our sewer plant certificate, due January of 2026. We have been fortunate in the past couple decades to get re-certified for 10-year intervals as long as we continued to maintain the sewer plant to Florida and EPA standards. With changes in the Florida laws and the National EPA over the past couple years, we would be happy to be re-certified for 5 years, but we're aiming for 10 years.

We are also fortunate to have Bill. He has been invaluable in keeping the plant and lift station working to its capacity and functioning at the proper levels. When you see Bill, give him a high five and thank him for what he does.

Most importantly, the sewer plant needs an expensive piece of equipment added to it to help us assure the passage of the recertification process. This sensor costs approximately \$12,000 and is a permanent addition to the plant. It continuously measures and monitors the nitrates and ammonia in our effluent (the water that leaves the plant and goes into the ponds) and keeps us abreast of any issues we may need to be aware of.

Needless to say, there is nothing more important than maintaining our sewer plant and lift station. We have procured the services of a professional lift station maintenance company to perform regular maintenance and emergency repairs for our lift station, relieving Bill of those duties.

Flushing your toilet is something we all take for granted. If this privilege is ever taken away from us, think of the consequences.

The pool has been experiencing some algae issues and other minor problems, but remains safe to use. With our focus on the sewer system, we plan to drain the pool, acid wash it and work on the algae problem sometime in the early part of next year when it's more available for this type of work. Please continue to use the pool and know Bill will not allow anyone to use it if it is unsafe.

According to standard accounting principles, our maintenance reserve is just slightly below the 50% threshold we would like to maintain. Currently we stand at 47%, which is expected after the sewer plant maintenance issue




