



Service Disclosure

Extending Christ's Care

The Church may share information about available resources but does not evaluate or endorse Service Providers.

1. Independent Status and No Authority.

Any individual or organization (“Service Provider”) whose information is shared by Freedom in Christ Church (“Church”) operates independently and is not an employee, agent, or representative of the Church, and is not authorized to act on the Church’s behalf.

2. No Endorsement or Approval.

The Church does not endorse or verify any Service Provider or the services they offer.

3. No Representation of Relationship.

The Service Provider may not present themselves as affiliated with or acting on behalf of the Church, or use the Church’s name in any way that implies approval or sponsorship.

4. Independent Responsibility.

All services are provided independently by the Service Provider, who is responsible for their own services and professional conduct.

5. Limitation of Liability.

The Church is not responsible for the services provided or any outcomes resulting from those services.

6. No Supervision or Control.

The Church does not oversee the Service Provider or their services, and sharing their information does not create any relationship with the Church.

7. Protection of Vulnerable Individuals.

The Service Provider understands that some individuals may be vulnerable and agrees to provide services with care, integrity, and respect.

8. Acknowledgment.

By allowing the Church to share their information, the Service Provider affirms their independent role and agrees to these expectations.
