## WHAT I NEED FOR CLASS

All class students must wear hair up off the shoulders and away from the face. Denim, jeans, skirts or shoes other than sneakers are not permitted. Students will sit during the class if they are not dressed properly with our dress codes.

### TAP STUDENTS:

will need tap shoes. Shoes can be ordered at the desk. Or you may purchase them at an area store .

### BATON STUDENTS:

may borrow a baton during classes, however, students must own their own baton for participation in shows, parades and our year end recital. Batons can be purchased at the desk.

### HIP HOP:

students may wear any "hip hop" style clothing they wish to wear. Sneakers or soft soled shoes are mandatory. Hats and accessories are encouraged. This is a fun, fun class! Show your style!

### Tumbling:

students should wear socks, as sometimes we will remove shoes. Clothing should not be loose and baggy.
