At the last meeting, of August 20, our guest speaker was Peter Glass PHF of the Robertson Environment Protection Society. Peter is a long standing member of the Rotary Club of Bulli and told us of some of the achievements of that club: the rebuilding of Bulli lookout (familiar to many members), the establishment of the Wollongong hospital dialysis unit, as well as the outcome of the tragic loss of a member's wife to a funnel web bite, which, with support from Rotary, ultimately led to the development of the present anti-venene.

The Robertson Environment Protection Society was started in 1990 with the aim of protecting the remnants of the Robertson rainforest. The group has been successful in publishing a book on the Rainforest, with over 1000 copies sold. They publish a newsletter 6 times a year and are successfully engaging local school kids in propagating local native plant species – what a great initiative!

Our Youth Director John Flockton told the meeting that he has had contact with the local PCYC, the manager of which is wanting to re-establish the previous relationship with Rotary. Roger suggested we could involve some of the 22 vulnerable kids who go to PCYC, in one of our Market Days, for the experience. John is following up.

Golf Day September 27 – Our annual Golf Day is our major fund raiser for the year, with the Golf Day Committee, chaired by Peter Nelson, working all year to prepare for the event. 15 teams are in and 16 sponsored holes are confirmed – great work on the part of the Committee! ## Dr Peta Seaton AM Bio Archaeology

Peta grew up in New Guinea and the Solomon Islands. She pursued her childhood passion for Middle Eastern archaeology with an Honours degree at Sydney University.

She has a PhD from Sydney University and continues to work closely with the Director of projects at Pella, and Teleilat Ghassul in Jordan, Dr Stephen Bourke AM. She is a member of the ongoing field expedition to Pella.

Peta was elected as the State Member for Southern Highlands in 1996, has worked in senior policy and strategy roles with former Premiers, and has been a Board Chair or Director for the last 15 years including Hearing Australia, NDIS, BDCU, Bradman Foundation and Nepean Hospital.

She and Lachlan run a farm at Ashton Park, Moss Vale.

### Pella in Jordan

Peta will speak about the ancient site of Pella in Jordan, where the University of Sydney has been excavating for 43 years. One of the largest multiperiod sites in the region, Pella was occupied from 12,000 years ago to the Medieval/Islamic periods, and it continues to be home to a vibrant Jordanian

village community, with whom the Australian team has worked since 1979. Peta will also give a glimpse of life on a dig.
