Class History

Filled with excitement and bewilderment, we passed bravely(?) through the doors of C.H.S. in September, 1963. We mustered all our courage as we prepared to face a time of new and challenging things—we were to begin the first phase of our high school years.

Our class proceeded in the right direction with the election of class officers. Patricia Campbell—President, Douglas Cunha—Vice-President, Mary Ann Stima—Secretary, and Patricia Palmer—Treasurer emerged victorious. Under the guidance of Mrs. Fontanella and Mr. Raphaelides, we were ready to begin our first year.

Our first class function—a “Sock Hop”—was the brainstorm of Mr. Raphaelides. The dance was held after school in the gym. The music was provided by records. Even though admission was only a quarter, the gym still remained quite empty. Successful or not, our class maintained the honor of holding the first dance after school.

The year passed quickly and in early June plans were made for our first “real” dance—“Hawaiian Sunset.” We decorated the tennis courts with flowers and bright lanterns, added the music of the Idells, and produced our first successful outside dance.

Confident with the success of our freshman year, we began our second at C.H.S. Class officers, Vincent Costanzo—President, William Korzenowski—Vice-President, Mary Ann Ward—Secretary, and Lorraine Kozar—Treasurer, were elected to lead us through the year’s activities.

A blizzard stormed into Carteret one Saturday night in January, forcing us to postpone our “Winter Wonderland” dance to the following week. The following Saturday the gym (where members of our class modestly accepted many praises for the decorations) was filled with a capacity crowd.

Still dizzy with the success of our first dance, we began to make plans for our second, “Heat Wave,” which was held in the spring. Once again, we profitted greatly.

Junior year was headed by the team of Robert Moorman—President, Janet Sabo—Vice-President, Anne Campbell—Secretary, and Elizabeth Torre—Treasurer. There was great excitement in October, for we were measured for Junior rings.

For the first time in the history of C.H.S., our Junior Class smashed the Senior Class in the annual Powder Puff Football Game. Score 21 to 6!

Plans were made for the first dance of the year, and “Bourbon Street Beat” was held in the fall. Again, our class went all out in decorations, and the dance was deemed a huge success.

March arrived and so did our Junior rings. At last, we were officially upperclassmen.

On April 1 and 2 the “Miracle Worker,” under the able direction of Mr. Sotak, was produced. A well-characterized cast with lead roles shared by Eileen Walsh and Mary Bruss was responsible for the total success of the play.

Checkered tablecloths and flickering candles adorned the tables on that “special” night. Our Junior Prom, “Le Moulin Rouge,” was held at the New Brunswick Inn.

Junior year ended rather sadly when we learned that Mr. Raphaelides received a new teaching position at Fairleigh Dickinson University.

At last we were Seniors! Mr. Panigrosso willingly(??) agreed to become our new advisor. Election results showed class offices filled by Barry Schutz—President, Patricia Del Rocco—Vice-President, Betty Ann Feeney—Secretary, and Diane Powers—Treasurer.
