Editor's Note



The season opened with four unsuccessful scrimmages, which did not tear the team apart, but actually unified them. This was team effort, primarily led by fourteen seniors, driven by the will to win.

The first two games were played in the blistering heat of late September. The two conference favorites, Rumson and Roselle Park did not alter nor abolish plans for winning the conference. Each team was defeated, 13-8 and 20-8, respectively. The third and fourth games were against Metuchen and Roselle, two other conference rivalries. Carteret pulled through again with 33-6 and 14-0 victories, giving the team an undefeated record going into the fifth game. The only defeat of the season was against Matawan 14-6. The defeat injured the pride but only increased the desire.

The two most eventful games were the Highland Park and Woodbridge games. Highland Park, a 7-year old nemesis, was vying for the conference title, and Woodbridge was a strong Group 4 team out to run over Carteret with a fifteen game winning streak. The challenge was great and the team accepted. They had to be stopped!

Carteret played their hearts out in the Highland Park game, which was perhaps the most emotional game ever. Hitting, hurting, and halting, Highland Park was defeated 12-7 on a last two-minute touchdown by the driving Roadrunners. Happiness radiated from the team members as they carried Coach Gilrain from the field. The toughness of the Wolfpack again pulled together a fine game against Woodbridge and, with the aid of another thrilling two minutes to go touchdown by the Roadrunners, an 8-7 victory was claimed. Two great games back to back!

Clifford Scott, the last home game of the season and the last home game ever for fourteen seniors, was a pounding triumph of 30-0. The last game was a heart-breaking 6-6 tie with Perth Amboy as the traditional Thanksgiving Day game. As the team sat outside the locker room, the words of Coach Gilrain lingered in their minds: "You are the finest bunch of men I have ever had the pleasure of coaching. Let us thank God for the successful season that we have had and always remember that one is never too almighty to get down on his knees to thank God."
