## Senior Spotlight

Although Carteret's Basketball team compiled a record which was not one of the very best in the county, the team effort was one of the best that Carteret has had in a long time. The Ramblers started out posting three consecutive wins over Edison, Saint Mary's, and Cedar Ridge before bowing to Metuchen. The team kept their momentum going by finishing a strong third in the Holiday Festival Christmas Tournament, by scoring impressive wins over tough teams from Sayerville and Saint Joseph's, and losing to an old nemesis, Perth Amboy.

The "hoopsters" success suddenly turned sour and a few bad breaks helped cause a painful losing streak. Included in this losing streak, were heartbreaking losses to Perth Amboy and J.P. Stevens, each loss by a single point. A few more losses brought the Rambler's record to a dismal 5-9 mark. But the team failed to crack under pressure, and came back to win five games in a row, including the big overtime upset victory over Woodbridge, along with the tough victory over South River. The streak came to an end, with a disappointing four point loss to a tough J.F. Kennedy club.

Upon entering the county tournament, the Ramblers regained their momentum and scored another impressive win over Woodbridge, but then fell victim to Perth Amboy, once again losing in a close decision. In the state tournament, the sluggish Carteret team shook off the Amboy defeat and readily disposed of Madison Township in the first round of play. The second round of play pitted the Ramblers up against a powerful Ocean Township team that possessed a $23-2$ record. The Carteret team played inspired ball and almost upset the Ocean team before losing by five points.

The Ramblers ended the season with a 12.12 record, which was one of the best in recent years. Much of the credit for the successful season belongs to the dedication of the coaches Mr. Pete Kindzierski and Mr. Bill Karatz, as well as to Mr. Gene Barrett, whose constant support aided the Rambler spirit. As Coach Kindzierski once put it, "Basketball is once more respectable in Carteret."
