Since its conception last year, the Carteret scoccer team has made an incredible surge to the top. The culmination being a 3-1 victory over three time state champion Jamesburg to attain the bragging rights as the best soccer team in Middlesex County. However, to make up for its lack of experience, the season started in June for many players. They realized they would have to combine hustle, desire, and skill to gain respect in the Middlesex County Conference. Another obstacle was the loss of 16 players due to graduation. Only three players, Randy Krum, Dennis McFadden, and Billy Behany returned to the varsity squad as seniors. To the delight of Coach Gonczlik and Coach Cowan, the season started successfully with a number of victories and a key win over previously unbeaten Perth Ambov. 5-4, in double overtime. Carteret's continued success was attributed to the hard working, predominately senior line-up which consisted of forwards Randy Krum and Jim Panaccione, wings Tony Mazzola and Jim Babjak, halfbacks Dennis McFadden, Al Malave, and Billy Behany, fullbacks Andy Kaskiw, Tom Kurdyla, Sal Aurelio, and Goalie George Dewitz. To add to its great season, Carteret managed to put Randy Krum, junior Don Mahler, George Dewitz, Dennis McFadden on various All-County teams, while Randy and Don were also being named to one of the All-State teams. 


The season officially opened in the blistering heat of September. The days were marked by hard work and sacrifice in preparation for the opening game versus South River.






















The Road Back
