Science



Science: Advancing Into the Future

With our technological advancing world, the heed for the knowledge of science becomes a dire necessity. The lack of understanding in the number of scientists, engineers and technologists. One of the reasons for this problem is that many schools play down this important and heed of science education. This is why the Science Department urges all students to study as much information in the sciences as they can possibly manage. Our Science Program offers an exceptionally good background in many areas of science—from space travel to collecting animals.

The Marine Science course concerns itself with the sea and the use of the shore as a classroom offering exposure to classroom objectives theories. The classes have explored the Arthur Kill and Barnegat Bay, have gone on trips to State Fisheries, The New York Aquarium and participated in fossil hunts in Middletown. They have also integrated the New York-New Jersey Conference in Marine Science held in Kingsborough College.

Advanced Science and Teep are two important courses dealing with the growing medical world. Advance Science is available to seniors interested in many fields from nursing to physical therapy. The class is made up of 25% biochemistry and 75% organic chemistry. Examining the human body, dissecting the fetal pig, participating in blood studies and bone cross sections are some of the classroom activities. Since the high school is connected with three area hospitals, Teep is devised for your chosen field. A student interested in nursing for example, will go to one of these hospitals and actually work with nurses to become introduced into the profession. This also applies to any oth-

er occupation dealing with the medical field. If you are interested Advanced Science and Teep are two of the best and most important classes to help prepare for your future.



English

English

English courses try to give students background opportunities. English prepares for students' future, whether one goes to college or out to work.

Humanities, for instance, helps students to understand and deal with other peoples customs, beliefs, and their cultures.

Modern Short Stories shows basically the literature in U.S. Literature and explains the authors opinion of society and peoples actions.

Literary Genres describes all forms of literature that is popular in the 20th century.

Oral and Written teaches students how to write and publicly speak.

Business English teaches grammer for future business careers.





Public Speaking

Public speaking is a course concerned with basic speech knowledge and skills. This is an elective given to freshmen and sophomore students. Public speaking is designed to improve student skills in human relationships and to improve effective critical listening, as well as to help students develop their abilities in both informal speaking situations and in the organization and presentations of specific material. Several formal and informal speech activities are offered to give the student a wide range of experience.



Play Production

Play production is a course offered to study the various approaches to acting. During the class students perform activities related to all aspects of theater and television. Most students enjoy the class very much and it often encourages the students to try out for the yearly school play. A very important part of the course is that it provides the student with a keener awareness of the theater.

Mass Media

Mass Media is a course offered to Junior and Senior students. It explores the major mass media . . . newspapers, magazines, radio, television, and movies, to determine their relationships to each other and to the students and their world. The students study the media theoretically, historically, and practically. Among the assignments for class is a project in which the students must develop a media ad campaign. The students are then required to design a magazine ad, write and records a radio commercial and write and layout a television commercial. The class is quite informative and provides good ground for students interested in the media.

History

HISTORY

The history department is broken down and specialized. History is a required course to graduate.

History is now broken down into different areas and eras; such as 20th Century, American Democracy, World History, etc. There is also Current Times which consists of Today's problems. There is also a course about youth in law.

The history courses try to fulfill the needs of the students themselves.



PSYCHOLOGY

The course of Psychology is basically for senior college prep students.

Mrs. Hays teaches Psychology and goes over material that would be found in freshman college classes. The course consists of:

1. Personality theories starting with the father of Psychology, Freud.
2. Healthy personality: the student gains insight into themselves.
3. Abnormal behavior such as:
 - a. neurosis - mental disorder
 - b. psychosis - personality disorder

The class involves rap sessions. Where problems come up, with the group being made up of teenagers, try to help one another. Discussions about peer pressure and parental pressures come up. The class tries basically to help students know themselves better.

The class is different, because there are a lot of exceptions because everyone is different. Mrs. Hays always says, "If you don't like yourself no one else will."



Math



The classes that are taught are Algebra I and II, Geometry, Trigonometry, Senior Math, Basic Computer Course, and General Math I and II.

This year, the law states that everyone must have two math classes. It's in effect in all schools.

College Prep students take Algebra to prepare to go onto college. In addition they also learn math for everyday living.

General students learn everyday types of math to go out into the world. For example, buying a car, interest rates, insurance, and going to a restaurant and figuring out the bill.



Industrial Arts

Industrial Arts

Industrial Arts shops are not operated in the classical, structures, academic areas of Carteret High School. In the shops, the individual ability of the student is stressed. There are norms in which we must adhere, but, they are the minimum requirements of functional performance. "Hands-On" ability is not the only factor in measuring performance. The ability to interpret written instructions and informative material is necessary.

In the Industrial Arts shop areas, individualized instruction is of primary consideration. No two students have the same level of ability. Therefore, after a lecture/demonstration of a particular function to be learned in handling a tool or a machine, the instructor must apply himself more to the slow learner. When teaching basic tool handling and machine operation, the technique does not vary. It must be simple, concise, and complete.

In the future, we hope to have an Industrial Arts major similar to the College Prep and Business Education. The students will be permitted to take two to four periods per day of Industrial Arts courses, with double periods in the eleventh and twelfth grades to better prepare them for jobs in industry.



Language

FOREIGN LANGUAGE DEPARTMENT

French, German, and Spanish courses are available to the student body from Freshman year to Senior year.

In addition to the mastery of language skills, students have excellent exposure to foreign culture. Language study opens new horizons.

The advanced levels of study enable a deeper concentration on the technical aspects and a greater appreciation of the cultures.

The department's aim is to offer an understanding and appreciation of another peoples' way of life, literature, and civilization through language.



Home Economics

Single Living

The class is for both Junior and Senior boys and girls. The course is a half-year course which teaches meal planning, nutrition, consumerism, and survival cooking. But that's not all they are taught. They're taught about decision making, apartment hunting, leasing an apartment, clothing care, and home care. They are also taught about checking accounts and loans. In that class, just about every thing a person needs to know for living on their own or having a home, is taught.



Fine Arts



Art and Fashion Design

The course is a full-year course for Juniors and Seniors. The class surveys the textiles and clothing industries. Their main concern is DESIGN. The subjects that they go over are color, theory, advertising, jewelry design, textile, and textile design.

The factors that influence design are social and psychological atmospheres, principals of lines and design, principals of balance, harmony, proportion, emphasis, and rhythm.

In the class, they go over fashion careers and opportunities in the industry. They learn interior design, designing of fabric products, and sketching the fashion figure. They do weaving and go on class trips to fashion shows, department stores, to a wool farm and many other interesting places.

The class is divided into a semester of Mr. Peters and the other semester Mrs. Lyons.



Business

Business

There are 13 teachers and 22 courses. The new courses taught are Sophomore Business Math and Machine Shorthand, which helps prepare students for careers as a court stenographer.

Two cooperative education programs are Cooperative Office Education and Distributive Education. These programs allow students to work in offices, banks, and food services during the school day.

Senior Business students receive instruction and training in a simulated office environment where they use the latest pieces of typewriting, word processing, and duplicating equipment available.

Business students also actively participate in Future Business Leaders of America (FBLA), and Distributive Education Clubs of America (DECA) activities on the regional, state, and national levels. Students have participated in conferences at Cherry Hill, Playboy Club at Great Gorge, New Orleans, Washington D.C., Miami, Chicago, and Los Angeles.

This year Carteret High School students, received specialized training in word processing concepts and techniques, utilizing the facilities of the Cittone School in Edison, New Jersey.

Attitudes, skills and actual career experience available to students in the business department leave a lasting impression on all students who participate and take advantage of business department offerings and opportunities.





Physical Education

Physical Education, Health, and Driver's Theory, are all part of the student's curriculum in high school.

Courses available in physical education, to name a few, are archery, fitness training, weight training, soccer, softball, and many more.

Health is taught to Freshmen, Sophomores, and Seniors. Topics discussed are smoking, drugs, mental health, diseases, nutrition, marriage, Sex Ed, etc.

To Juniors, driver's theory is presented. In this class, all students try their hardest to pass the exam in order to receive their permits.

The Carteret High School Choir has grown in size and developed in quality. They wish to expand their repertoire. The Choir devotes much time to practice after school and in the evenings.

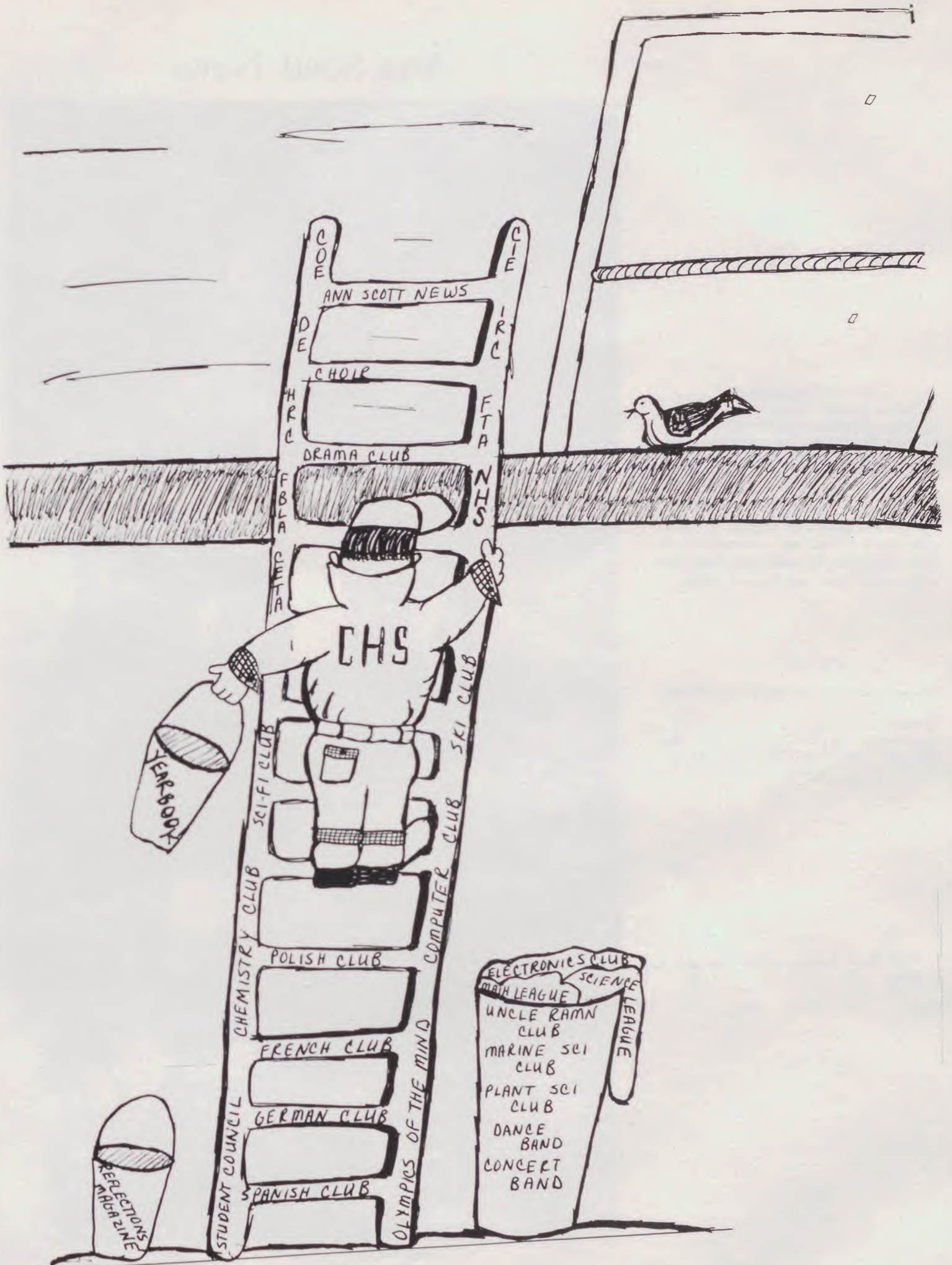

VICA also offers prestige and recognition through a national program of awards and contests. It broadens perspectives through interclub and interstate activities that make education and training more meaningful.

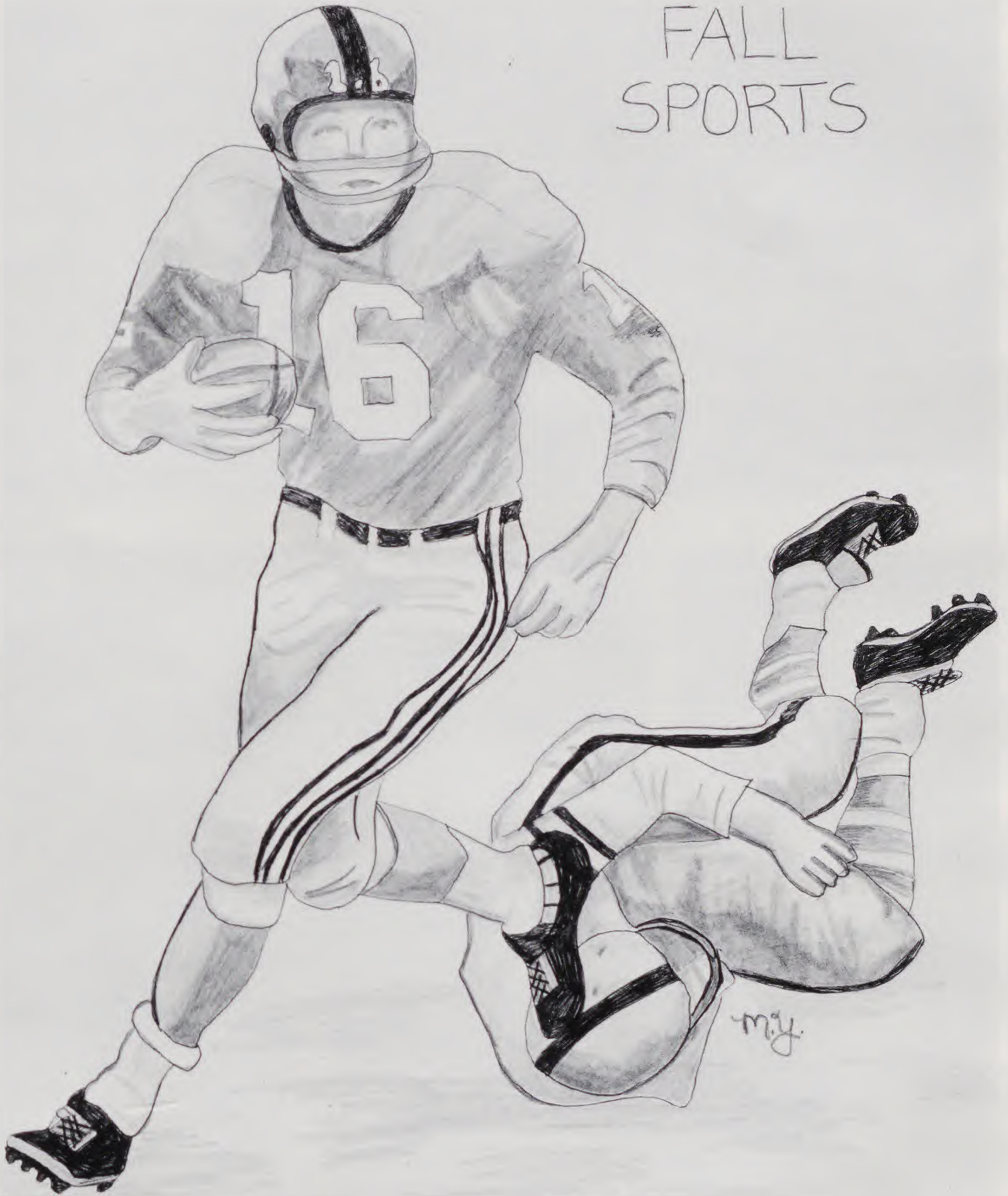

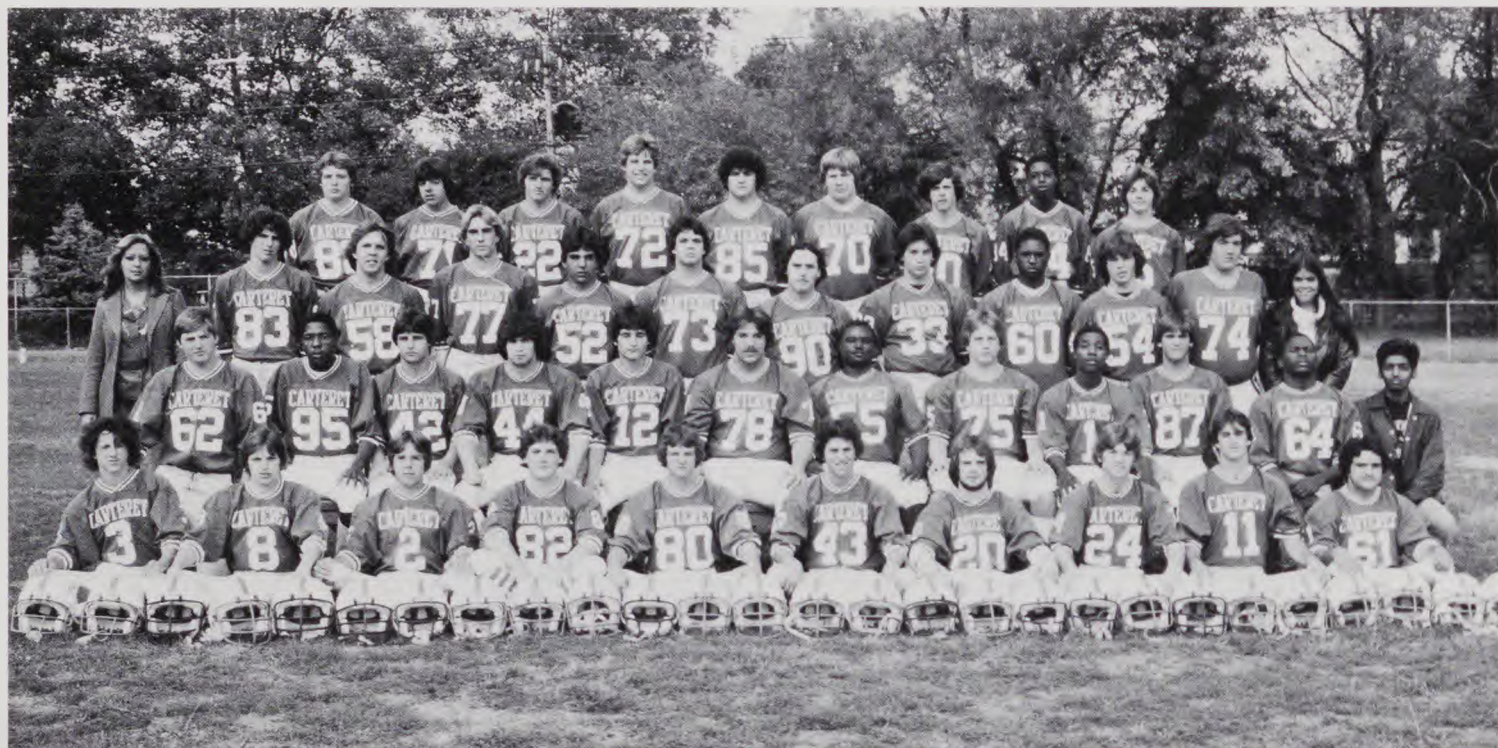

Carteret Football

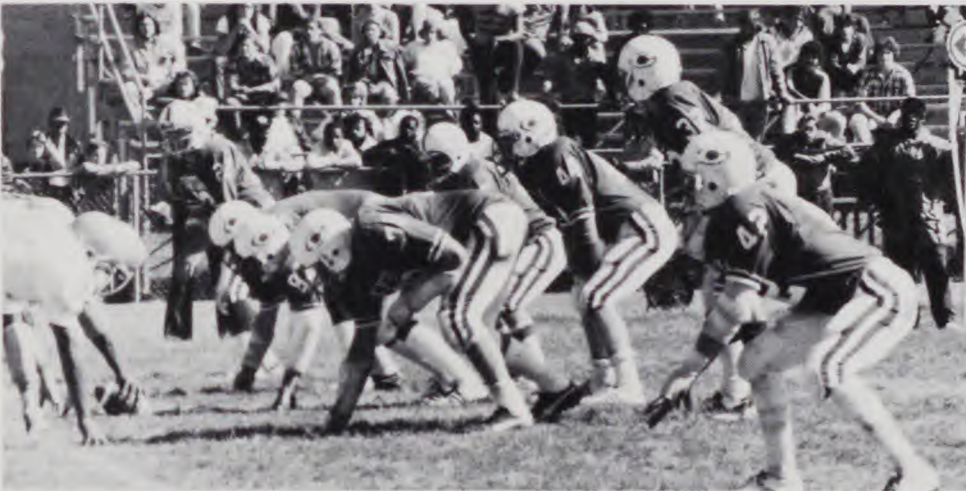

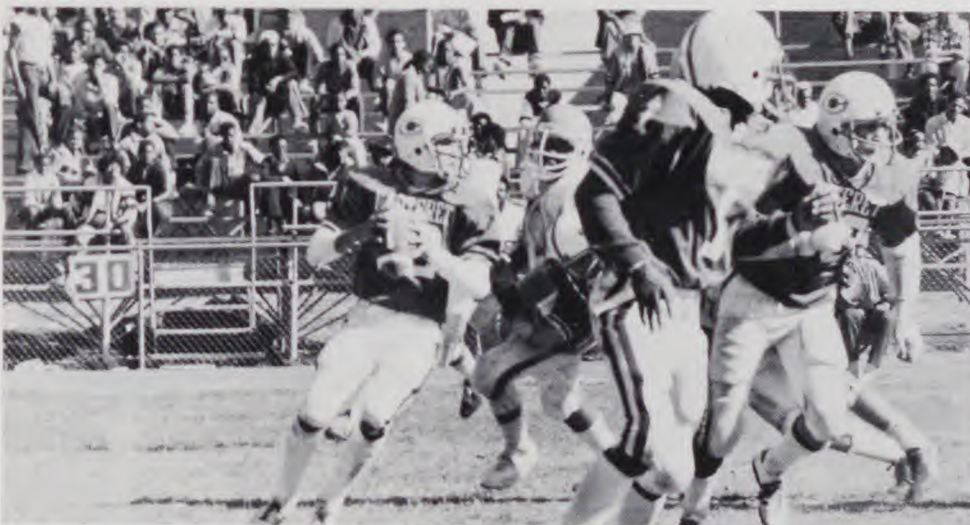

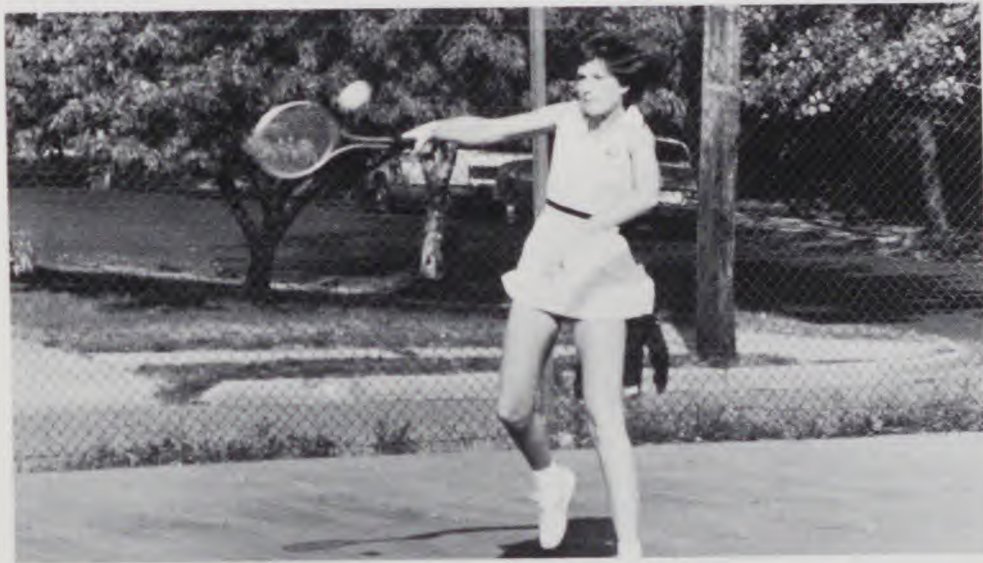
Tennis

Girl's Cross Country

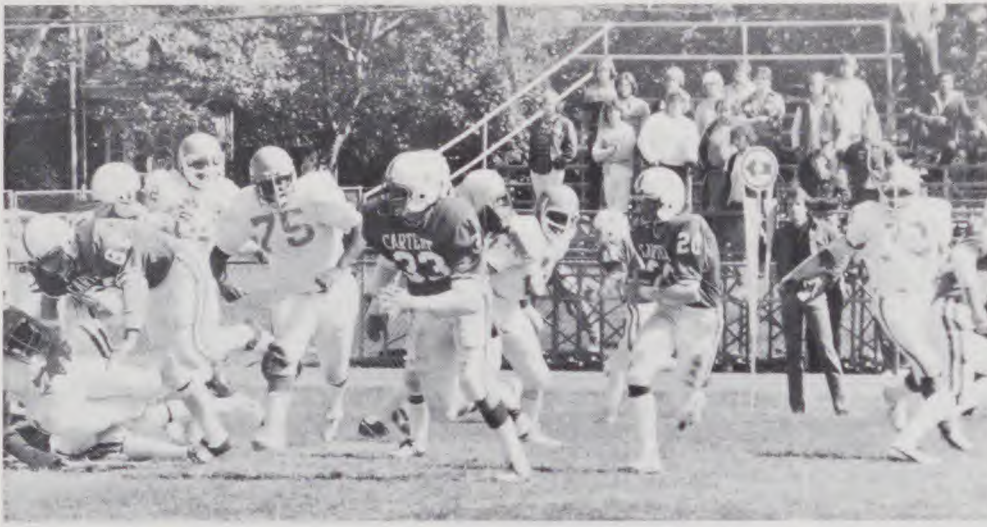

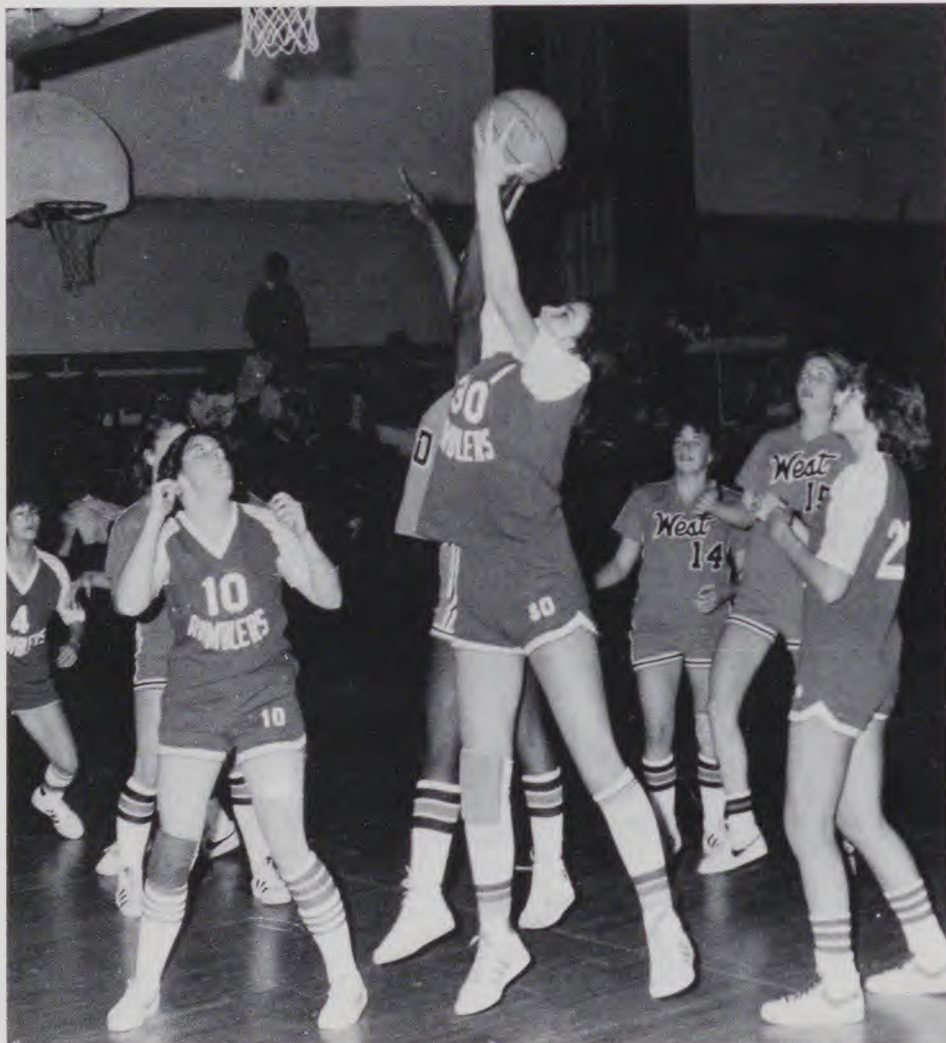

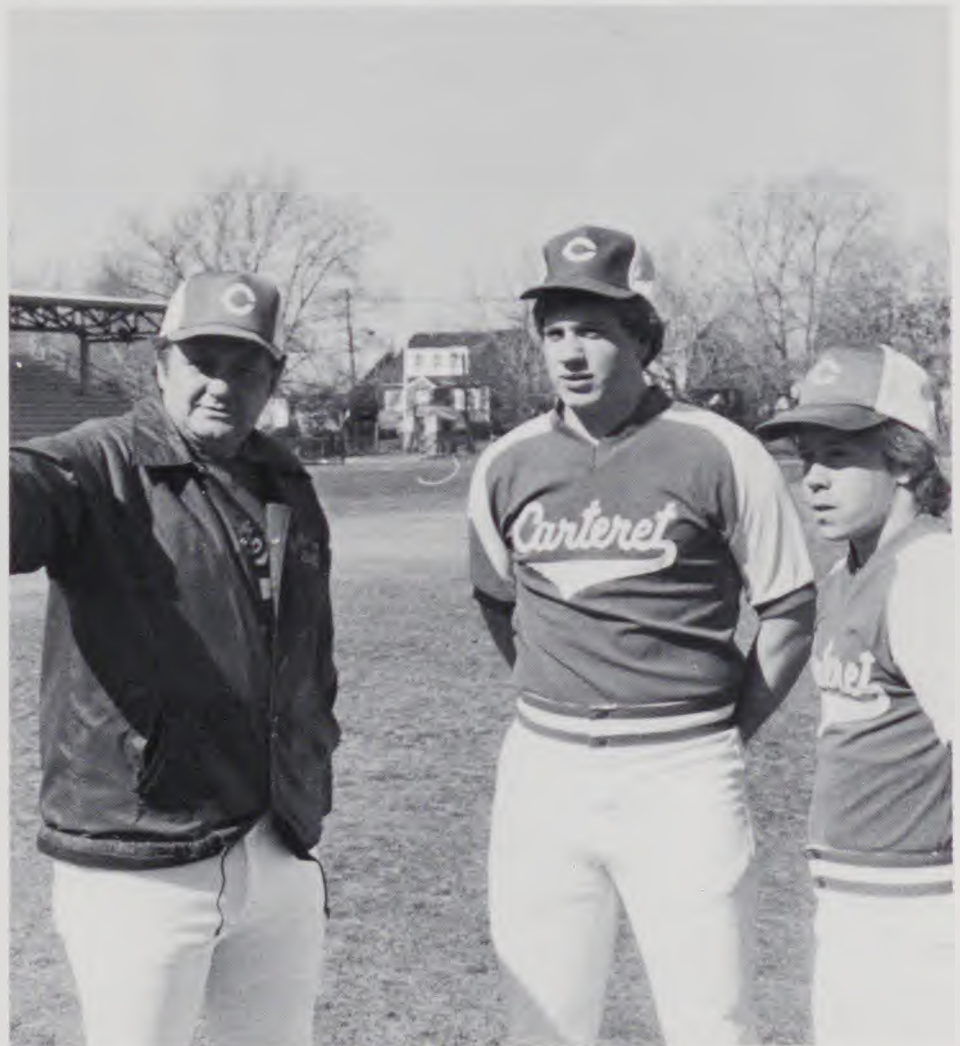
