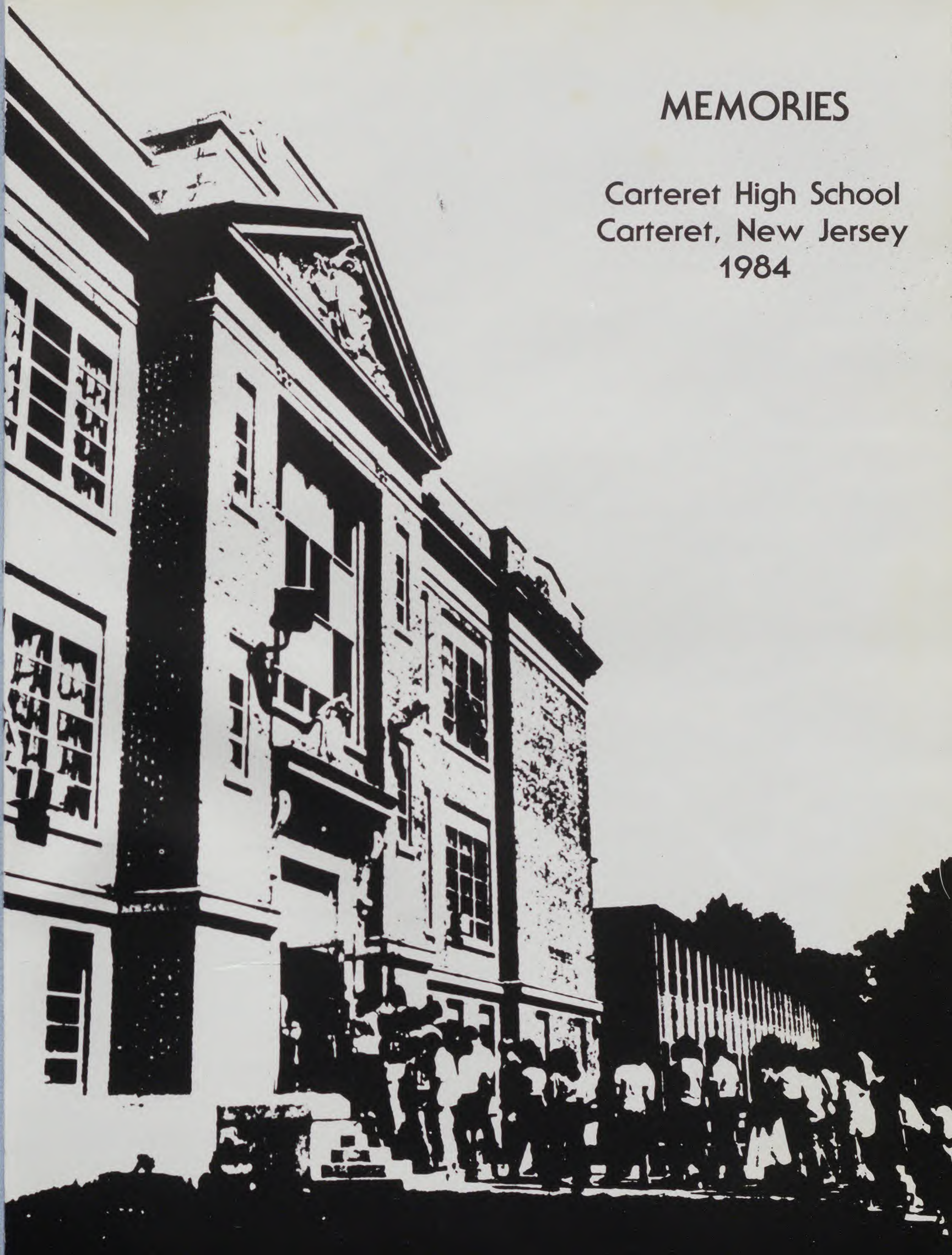

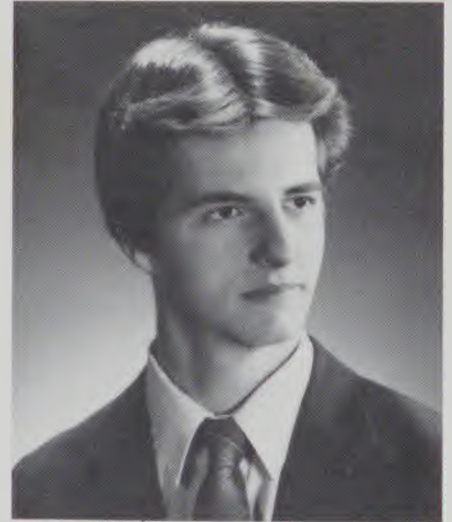

Editor's Note

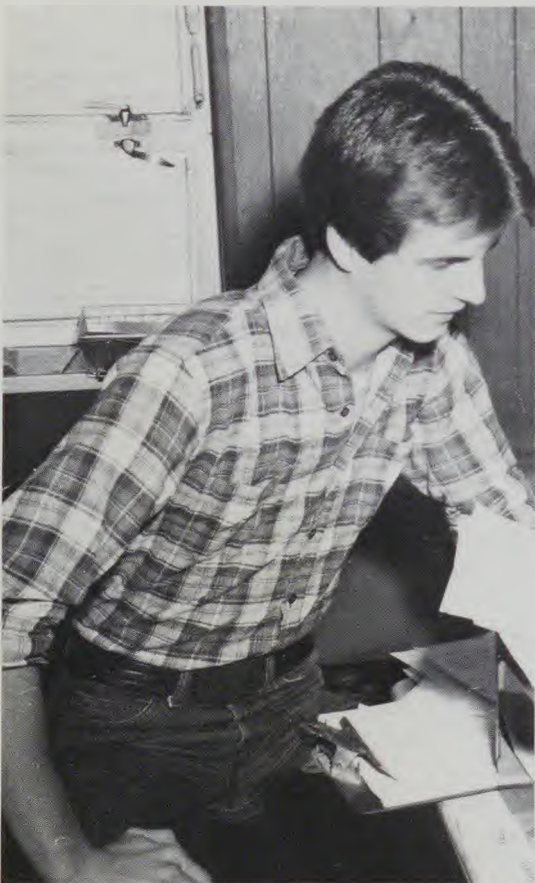

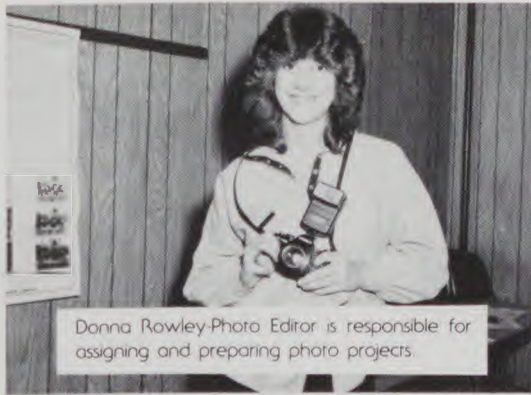
Also new this year was the introduction of a Yearbook homeroom. In this way, staff members meet everyday and are able to keep up on the latest activities and approaching deadlines.

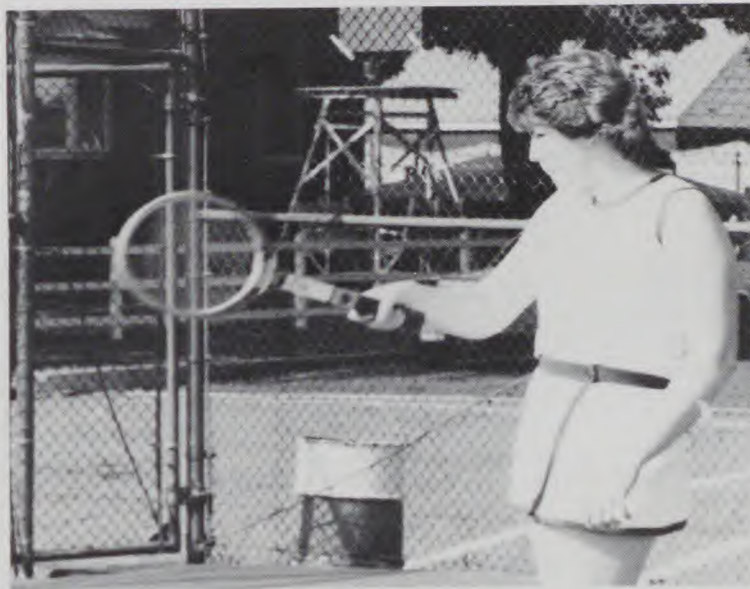
The 1983 Girls' Tennis Team completed a 7-13 season in a very rough Bicentennial Athletic Conference.
