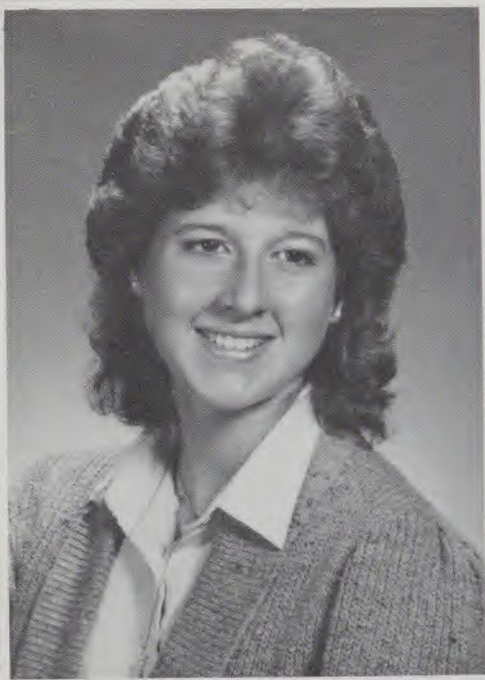

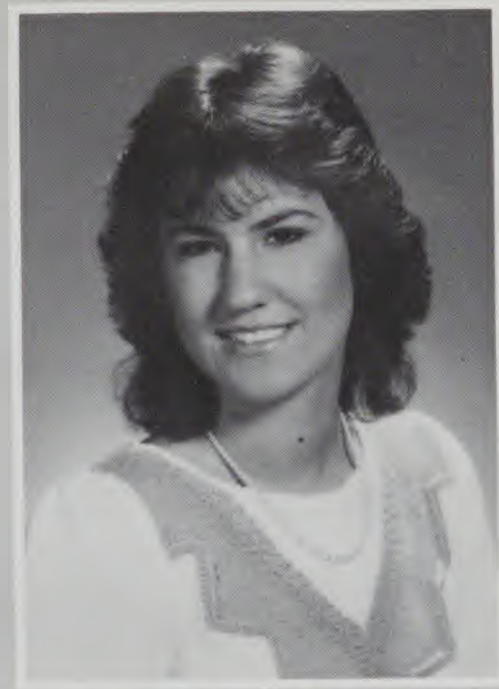

Mr. John Robert Yustak

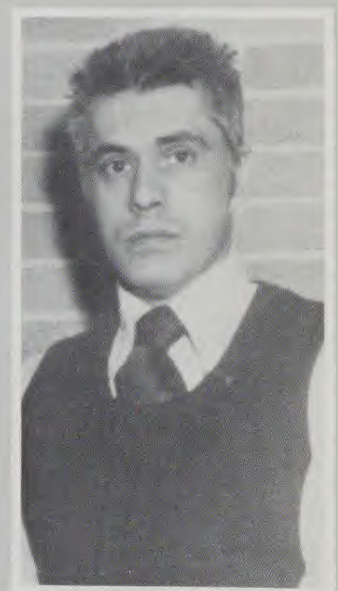

It is now time to move on, and even though everyone will go his own way, we can thank Carteret High for bringing us together for these very special years and giving us these memories that will last a lifetime.

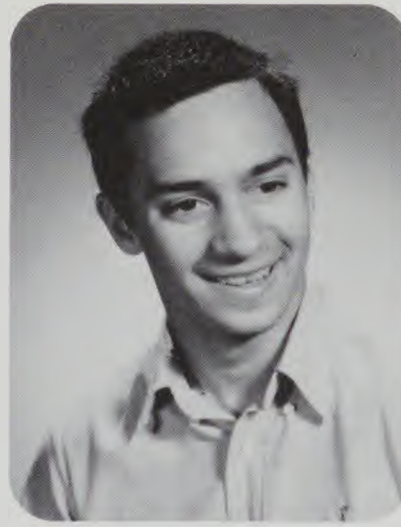

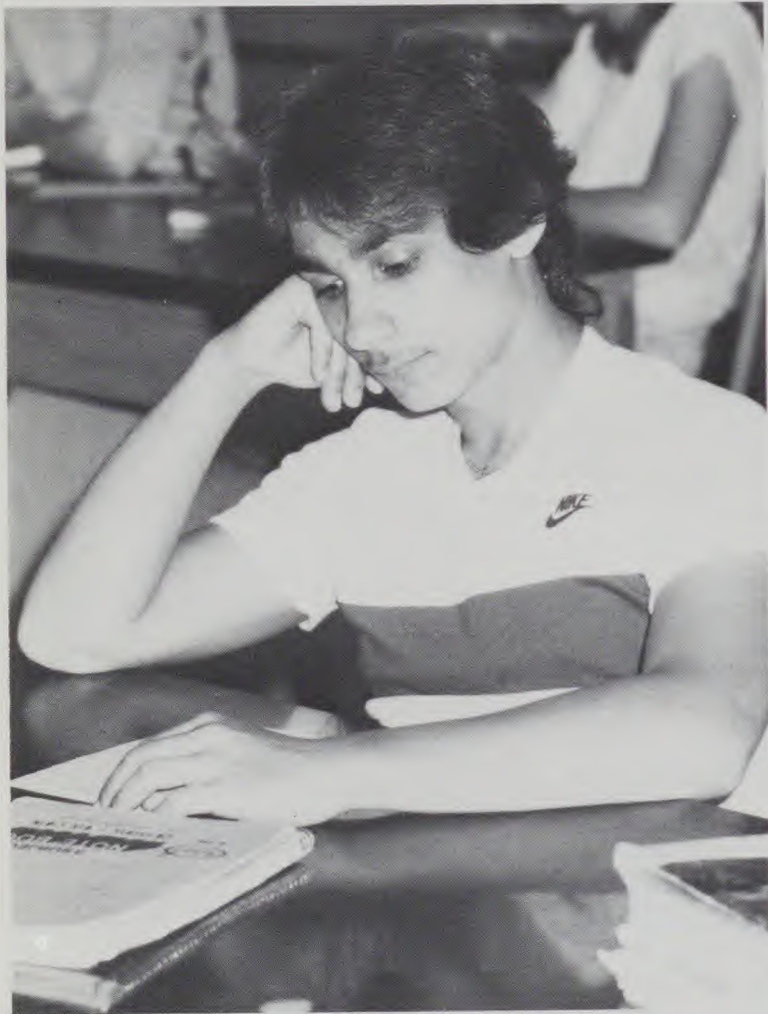
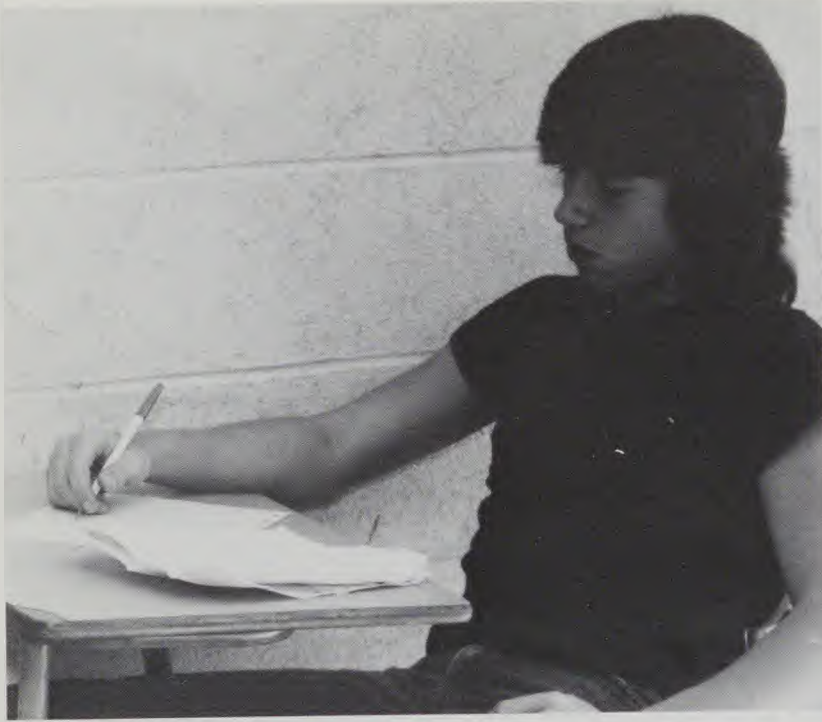
Homecoming "84" was held on November 10. The ceremonies took place during half-time of the last home football game.

All five girls should be congratulated for their participation in this year's ceremonies and reminded that they are all winners.









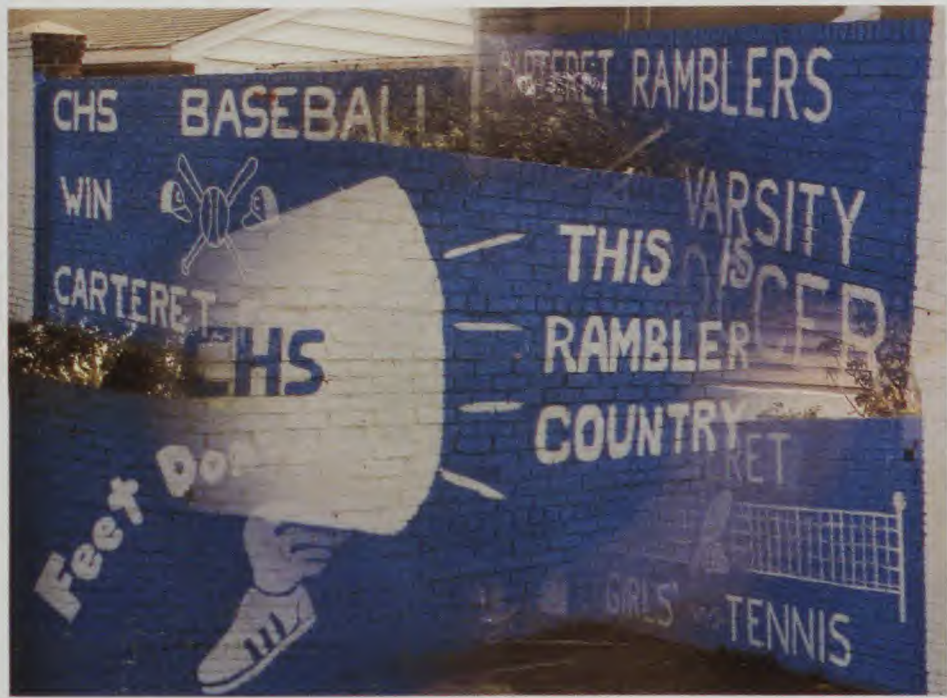

Hopefully the leadership provided by the departing seniors and the success the underclassmen experienced will combine to give the 1985 season a successful start.

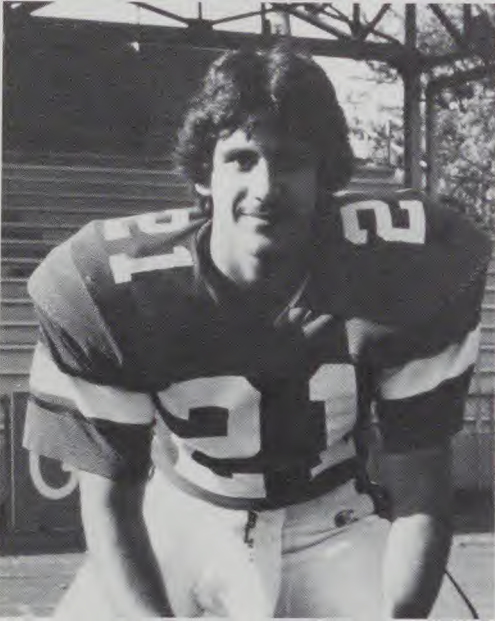

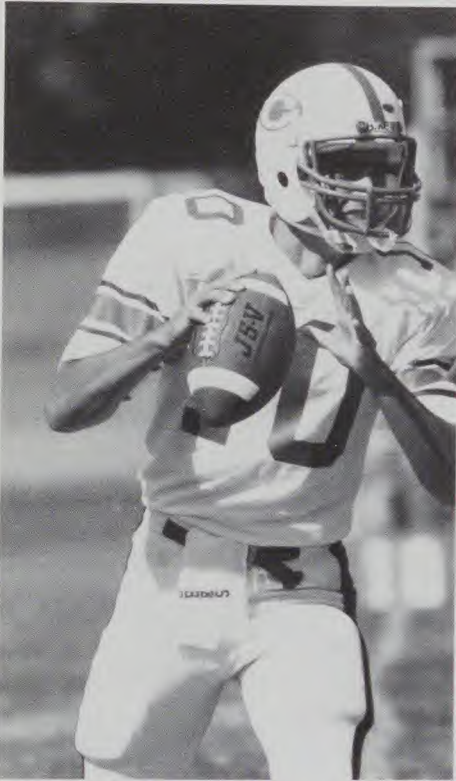
